Fr Michal Aronowicz (aged 44, arrested in [Belarus](#) on charged of 'contacts with Polish nationalists' on [February 17, 1951](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [August 11, 1951](#); **UPDATE**: arrived at camp)
