Watchman Nee aka Ni Tuoseng (aged 48, husband of Charity Chang, arrested on charges of bribery, tax evasion, and theft of state property and government economic information but in reality for refusing to join the official Three Self Help church)

Fr Jozef Grasiwicz (aged 49, arrested in [Nova Ruda](#) on [November 2, 1951](#); sentenced on [January 23, 1952](#) to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: sent to Minlag)

Romania

Fr Clementte Gatti OFM (aged 72, Italian national, arrested in [Bucharest](#) on [March 8, 1951](#), tortured; convicted of espionage on [September 17, 1951](#); **UPDATE**: released and put on a train for Vienna, upon arrival was found to be paralyzed, leaking fluid from his backbone, with bedsores, and unable to speak, hospitalized in Saccolongo, Padua, Italy)
