Fr Wojciech Dazicki O.Cist (aged 28, arrested in Krymok, Zhytomyr oblast, Ukraine earlier in the year, sentenced on July 31, 1946 to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Siblag, later transferred to Sevvostoklag; UPDATE: granted an early release, returned to his pastoral duties in Zhytomyr oblast, Ukraine)
