Russia: Rechlag, Vorkuta, Komi ASSR

Fr Jan Kapusta SDB (aged 54, arrested in Dzyatlava, Poland [now Belarus] in 1940, sent to a prison camp; amnestied as a Polish citizen in February 1942; arrested on August 10, 1942 as the Polish Armed Forces of the East was exiting the USSR into Iran; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on January 13, 1943, sent to Vorkutlag; transferred to Rechlag in 1948; UPDATE: released, sent into internal exile to the Yenisei region of Krasnoyarsk Krai)

Fr Martin Karas CSSR (aged 42, arrested on July 13, 1952; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)
