### Russia: Dubravlag labor camp, Yavas, Zubovo-Polyansk region, Mordovian ASSR

Fr Dominik Czeszek (aged 63, arrested on May 25, 1948; sentenced on July 30, 1948 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: granted early release, returned to Lviv, Ukraine)

# Russia: Kraslag labor camp

Fr Ryszard Grabski OFM Cap (aged 45, captured by German border guards in occupied Poland while illegally crossing from Soviet held territory in 1940, handed over to Soviet border guards, sent to Belostok Prison; sent to Kotlas, Arkhangelsk oblast in May 1941; arrested on August 23, 1942; sentenced on October 2, 1943 to 15 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Vorkutlag, later transferred to Kamyshlag; transferred on March 20, 1954 to Steplag in Kazakhstan; transferred on March 22, 1955 to Kraslag; UPDATE: transferred to Dubravlag, released in late 1955 or early 1956, emigrated to Poland)

#### Russia: Siblag labor camp, Novosibirsk

Fr Stanislaw Kudariewski (aged 67, arrested in Polock, Belarus on December 22, 1950, sent to Mogiliev Prison; sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on March 15, 1951; **UPDATE**: released, returned to Polock)

# Kazakhstan: Karlag labor camp, Akmolinsk sector

Sr Raisa Krylevskaya OP (aged 58, arrested in Kaluga, Russia on espionage charges on November 30, 1948; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on August 17, 1949, sent to Vorkutlag; transferred to Karlag in Kazakhstan in 1954; **UPDATE**: released early as an invalid, returned to Kaluga)
