**Russia: Moscow**

**UPDATE: Five Christians from Chernogorsk attempt to enter the U.S. Embassy, all were detained, the daughters were sent to an orphanage**

Peter Pavolvich Vashchenko (husband of Augustina Vasilovna Vashchenko, told that he would be tried as a traitor should he enter any embassy again for more than three hours)

Lida Vashchenko (aged 17, daughter of Peter and Augustina Vashchenko, later told her interrogator “Kill me” when threatened with a revolver)

Lyubia Vashchenko (aged 15, daughter of Peter and Augustina Vashchenko)

Nadya Vashchenko (aged 13, daughter of Peter and Augustina Vashchenko)

Vera Vashchenko (aged 12, daughter of Peter and Augustina Vashchenko)
