### **Lithuania: Moletai**

Fr Antanas Seskevicius (**UPDATE**: trial concluded on a charge of catechizing children, state witnesses all retracted their testimony, prohibited from introducing any defense witnesses, convicted, sentenced to one year at hard labor)

Nijole Sadunaite (aged 32, factory worker, sister of Jonas Aloyzas Sadunas, detained without charge during the trial of Fr Antanas Seskevicius for having paid for his legal counsel, interrogated, released at midnight)

Ona Brieliene (teacher with 21 years' experience, wife of Jurgis Briilius, family photographs of her children's First Communion obtained by the school administration in **October 1969**, harassing inspections of her classroom begun; dismissed by the Education Committee on **September 14, 1970**; appealed her dismissal to the People's Court on **September 28, 1970**; **UPDATE:** dismissal upheld, appeal filed with the LSSR Supreme Court)
