**Tuesday November 10, 1970**



### **Lithuania: Vilkaviskis**

Ona Brieliene (teacher with 21 years' experience, wife of Jurgis Briilius, family photographs of her children's First Communion obtained by the school administration in [October 1969](#), harassing inspections of her classroom begun; dismissed by the Education Committee on [September 14, 1970](#); appealed her dismissal to the People's Court; dismissal upheld on [October 14, 1970](#), appeal filed with the LSSR Supreme Court; **UPDATE:** appeal heard by the Supreme Court, order issued to reinstate her, however was not given a class assignment at the school, ignored by the other teachers)
