Wednesday December 23, 1970



### Lithuania: Vilkaviskis

Ona Brieliene (teacher with 21 years' experience, wife of Jurgis Briilius, family photographs of her children's First Communion obtained by the school administration in [October 1969](#), harassing inspections of her classroom begun; dismissed by the Education Committee on [September 14, 1970](#); appeal heard by the Supreme Court, order issued to reinstate her, however was not given a class assignment at the school, ignored by the other teachers; **UPDATE:** teacher's union again voted to dismiss her, was unable to find work)

Jurgis Briilius (husband of Ona Brieliene, forced to resign from his job after his wife's dismissal)

### Russia: Reshoty

Anna Petrovna Makarenko (aged 42, sister of Maria Petrovna Chmykhalov, arrested in [December 1968](#), later tired for internal passport violations – she had refused to get one; **UPDATE:** released from the labor camp without any money, told she would be rearrested if she boarded a train without the proper fare, sold two dresses her family had given her to buy her ticket)
