Fr Juozas Zdebskis (church in Prienai raided by the authorities on July 16, 1971 during his First Communion class for 300 children who were all questioned and photographed; arrested by the KGB on August 26, 1971 for illegal religious instruction to children; **UPDATE**: trial held, Christians were forcibly ejected from the courthouse and replaced with state employees before it began, said during the trial "You have shown me thousands of youths behind bars. Not one of them knows the God who should be loved and who loves us. No one has spoken to them of such a God; no one has taught them to find happiness in doing good to every human being, even to an enemy. I know very well that if we priests shall not speak about this, the very stones will begin to exclaim, and God will hold us responsible for their fate")
