### Russia: Chernogorsk

Lida Vashchenko (aged 24, maternity home worker, found a two month premature baby who had survived a [March 31, 1975](#) abortion in the clinic across the street, began to feed him;

**UPDATE:** legally adopted the baby, named him Aaron, surprised herself by saying to him “The whole world will find out about you”, later resigned her position to take care of him)

Aaron Vashchenko (aged 1 month, had survived being aborted on [March 31, 1975](#), **UPDATE:** legally adopted by Lida Vashchenko)
