Ukraine: Lviv

Fr Viktor Danilov (aged 49, released in 1955 from [Minlag labor camp, Inta village, Kozhvisk region, Komi ASSR](#), had become a Christian while in the camp thanks to priest inmates, after his release began decades of evangelization which included multiple occurrences of KGB questioning; **UPDATE**: secretly ordained to the priesthood, continued evangelical work across the Soviet Union, after the collapse of the Soviet Union became a pastor in Belarus)

Metropolitan Volodymyr Sterniul (aged 69, arrested in 1947, sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to [Arkangelsk in Russia](#), worked as a lumberman; lived in a single room above a paint shop, secretly ordained a bishop in [July 1964](#); **UPDATE**: secretly ordained Viktor Danilov to the priesthood)
