Monday March 30, 1980



El Salvador: San Salvador

Archbishop Oscar Arnulfo Romero y Galdamez (shot dead by an assassin during Mass on [March 24, 1980](#); **UPDATE**: funeral Mass interrupted by an attack on the 250,000 mourners in the street in front of the cathedral by snipers and thrown smoke bombs, **30-50 mourners killed**)

Cardinal Ernesto Corripio y Ahumada (Mexican citizen, concelebrated the funeral Mass of Archbishop Oscar Arnulfo Romero y Galdamez as the official representative of Pope John Paul II)

Sr Dorothy Kazel OSU (aged 40, U.S. citizen, missionary, took refuge in the cathedral)

Jean Donovan (aged 26, U.S. citizen, missionary, took refuge in the cathedral)
