Pakistan: Muridke

Tim Iqbal Masih (aged 12, anti-slavery activist, **shot dead**, sold into bonded labor at age 4, escaped at age 10 despite abuse and malnutrition, helped free 3,000 children from bonded labor [most Christians], in two years had completed four years of secondary school, had been accepted at Brandeis University in the United States, had said “I would like to do what Abraham Lincoln did...I would like to do it in Pakistan”)
