Archbishop Benjamin 'Ben' Argak Kwashi (aged 51, husband of Gloria Kwashi, home in Zaria, Kaduna state destroyed in religious rioting in March 1987; **UPDATE**: away in London at a church conference)

Gloria Kwashi (aged 47, wife of Archbishop Benjamin 'Ben' Argak Kwashi, home attacked by a Muslim mob intent on killing her husband, beaten, stripped, raped with a broken bottle and a mop handle, taken to the diocesan office in an attempt to trick the administrator to open the door, while hospitalized demanded that the church buy mosquito netting for the other patients, went blind five weeks after the beating, travelled to the United States for surgery that restored her sight)

Rinji (aged 19, son of Archbishop Benjamin 'Ben' Argak Kwash and Gloria Kwash, beaten unconscious)

Naminen (aged 6, son of Archbishop Benjamin 'Ben' Argak Kwash and Gloria Kwash, attempted to hit and bite the attackers, jaw broken)

Susan Essam (diocesan administrator, office invaded by the attackers, beaten, diocese robbed of UK£1,100)
