Aminu Sallau (aged 59, father of Usman Aminu, said "I was listening to news on the radio when nine armed Muslim men stormed my house. They came on three motorbikes and started shooting into the air. Three of them pointed their guns at my head and demanded I give them money. The gunmen were not happy that I had only a little money on me [US\$220], so they tied my hands and legs and were about to take me away when one of them, who was standing guard in front of my house, rushed in to tell his colleagues that he had shot and killed my son, Usman. On hearing this, I began to cry and shout, and in the midst of the confusion, the gunmen abandoned me and fled")

Bishop Juan Jose Aguirre Munos (**UPDATE**: reported to have said "Since the beginning of 2016 my diocese has been continuously under LRA [Lord's Resistance Army] attack and nobody talks about it. We have been attacked everywhere for over a month. The LRA has attacked more than six villages in the area. Here in Bangassou we have welcomed many displaced people who fled from Niakari area, where the diocese has a place of pilgrimage. In Niakari, last week, the LRA abducted and beat up the residents. Three days ago I went to Bakouma, where on January 21, the local mission had been ransacked, and I brought with me the two nuns and seminarians who were operating there. The LRA group that ransacked the Bakouma mission almost certainly enjoyed the complicity of a

Seleka group, the former Central African rebellion. For over two hours the nuns and seminarians were at the mercy of some fifteen armed men...What hurts me the most is that nothing is said about what happens in Bangassou, but we report the news such as the arrest of one of the LRA leaders, Okot Odek, who was captured far from Bangassou, in the north of the Country. Odek is a boy who had been kidnapped by the LRA and then became a criminal leader of this group. But there are several other LRA leaders who continue to hassle us")

- Kaneez Bibi (said "I work as a beautician but I did not go into work today. Our bosses told us to stay at home as they are not opening their businesses due to threats of violence. My family and I are bunkering down at our home and it is very frightening")
- Tariq Parvez (said "I work in a permaflex and printing company. I could not get through to work this morning. A large group of protestors threatened to beat me if I tried to reach my work premises. The group looked scary and was shouting out about how Kaffir [infidels] were ruining the country. I am fearful for my life and my family")
- Shakil Masih (music and fine art teacher, said "I was travelling to school and was stopped by protesters. They threatened to kill me and beat me on my back to send me home. I later called the school and found out it was closed, but no-one from management had contacted me")

Rafique Gill (scrap merchant, said "It is worrying that the protesters are in the streets with such animosity. So far Christian areas have not been attacked but there is, as yet, no extra policing for our communities. I have taken the risk of opening my business as it is far from the city centre and most of my clients are Christian. But if I am threatened I will close the shop. It is not worth the loss of life, even though I desperately need the money")

Shamim Masih (**UPDATE**: said "The Christians of Pakistan are in great fear and want the Government to ensure their safety. Threats have already been made to Christian communities and those who have fled their homes to escape to more rural areas will no doubt return to find their homes have been looted. Christians remember the attacks on the communities of Shati Nagar, Gojra and St Joseph's colony where mob violence resulted in loss of lives, homes and churches. They also remember the recent bomb attacks in Peshawar and Lahore, they do not believe extremist and conservative Muslims need much of a reason to attack them and feel the current climate is creating great animosity towards them")

Wilson Chowdhry (**UPDATE**: said "What chance do Christians have for survival in a nation that openly places hero status on murderers? Mumtaz Qadri was involved in the heinous murder of Governor Taseer, an act that traumatized Pakistan and brought to light the extent of extremism and hatred towards minorities in Pakistan. This man enjoyed privileges whilst in Pakistani prisons that few obtain and was able to spread his evil ideology within prison often coercing wardens to punish those involved in blasphemy cases - which contributed to the death of a British Prisoner. Most alarmingly the legal fraternity of Pakistan have come out in support for Mr. Qadri and declared a one day strike, an act that is a clear indictment of the extremism that is ubiquitous throughout all tiers of Pakistani Muslim society. The few voices of liberality in Pakistan will have an uphill struggle making the nation one that is egalitarian, yet in the meanwhile western nations including Britain have deduced that Christians in Pakistan rarely face persecution, a judgment that has led to the re-persecution of thousands of Pak-Christians stranded in Thailand")

I have been trying to reach many of my family members without success. We feel terribly let down by the government that announced a joint security team. We have not seen the security men - be they policemen or military, as I speak")

Pakistan

Komal (alias, said "I do not remember the exact date, but it was almost middle of June, the hottest month of 2015, when my misery started. I am 15-years-old, the youngest daughter of my elderly parents who work at a brick-kiln factory. They did not have enough of income for my education, therefore I have never been to school, although I wished. I was sleeping along with my mother on a single bed during a power-cut time in my house yard. Around midnight, five armed men with masks climbed over the boundary wall and entered into house. The armed men brutally beat the entire family and threatened them severe consequences if they shouted for help. Then, the kidnappers dragged me from my mother's lap to their car in the street. My eyes and mouth were covered with a piece of cloth and they took me to unknown place where five of them raped me in front of each other, taking turns. I think it was a neighboring city from where they kidnapped me...Burning my female parts with cigarettes was a routine exercise for them. The kidnappers often teased Christians, especially disrespecting Christian women. Almost for two months they beat me every day for nothing and did not give enough food to

eat...After almost two months of inhuman treatment and humiliation, they took me to a courthouse and forced me to put my thumb impression on a document that declared me the wife of a Muslim. I did not want this to happen, however, I had no other option because they threatened to kill my parents if I did not obey. Therefore, they forcefully married me to a Muslim and converted me to Islam. Without my wish they changed my religion, my identity and even my name. My new husband, who continued to rape me for the next two months, then moved to another city. This man already had two wives at his house...At this stage, I experienced the worst agony of all. I felt like dying every day when my husband forced me to have [relations] with other visitors for earning money. I had become a forced prostitute. He even hired a watchwoman to keep an eye on me almost round the clock. I spent the next six months in captivity. However, I had faith that Jesus would get me out of this hell. In February, I had a golden opportunity to escape. Before sun rose, I managed to sneak away from the house to an urban area after walking for about five hours. I begged for money from the people there to cover a bus fare and was able to reach my home after sunset on the same day...I am thankful for this mercy and the miracle of rejoining my parents now. I couldn't stop crying when I hugged my parents and family for the first time. One can hardly imagine the painful situation which I and my parents experienced. It was like rising from the dead. When I returned home, I was five months pregnant. I am confused about what to do with my unborn baby. What will the future of my child be if I give birth to him or her? I want justice, but do not want to put my parents into danger. Those people are very rich and influential and therefore we cannot go into the legal process against them. I just want to be divorced and try to plan a happier life")
