Myanmar: Mongkoe township, Shan state

Bishop Philip Lasap Za Hawng (expressed dismay over the military airstrike that destroyed a church "We are yet to know detailed facts but I will write a letter to the authorities, the military commander and chief minister of Shan State once I know everything...We need all the armed groups to participate in peace talks", all parishioners had already fled across the nearby border into China, sixty churches have been destroyed by the military in the region since 2011)

Mai Mai (aid worker, said that soldiers used a church during a battle before destroying it "They used the church to get protection. They could have been based somewhere else, but they chose the church to mix themselves with civilians...It is painful to see the church that was bombed. I am hurt to see they destroyed the church. This church is something that we highly admire and respect. In fact, it is not a forgivable act, but God teaches us to forgive and not to take revenge. So only God will punish them...Local residents are still afraid of going home. Some went back to stay in the day time and returned to the China border in the night time, because they dare not to sleep over night in the town")

Maher al-Gohary (convert, father of Dina, reported on [December 17, 2015](#) to have filed suit to change his religion on his national id card from Islam to Christianity, said he and his daughter have suffered persecution for years; home invaded in November 2016 by three men, threatened with death, forced to be photographed with signs that denounced Christianity and announced his return to Islam; **UPDATE**: has fled the country to Cyprus)

Dina (aged 22, convert, daughter of Maher al-Gohary, home invaded in November 2016 by three men, threatened with death, father forced to be photographed with signs that denounced Christianity and announced his return to Islam; **UPDATE**: has fled the country for Cyprus, said "My father did this for me, he protected me, and he always does")

Rania (aged 28, widow, husband killed by radical Muslims, father disappeared in 2015, said "They tried to make me convert to Islam, to change my religion and after my husband died, they are trying to make me marry a Muslim", has fled the country for Cyprus)

Governor Basuki Tjahaja Purnama aka Ahok (reported on [October 12, 2016](#) to have been accused of blasphemy in Jakarta after he stated that the Quran should not be used for political purposes, apologized, forgiven by some Muslims; object of a [November 4, 2016](#) demonstration in Jakarta by 150,000 Muslims with banners reading "Arrest Asok for insulting Islam" and "Kill Asok"; named as a suspect in a police blasphemy investigation on [November 16, 2016](#) despite the fact that a professor of communications has admitted to altering a recording of his original speech to incriminate him, prohibited from leaving the country, if convicted he could be sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: will be put on trial for blasphemy on December 13, 2016)

Malik Higenyi (aged 30, convert from Islam, son of Aimuna Namutongi , husband, father of two, beaten on [November 13, 2016](#) after publicly acknowledging his conversion, right hand broken, head injured, said “The attackers hit me with a blunt object, and I fell down and did not know what happened from there. I just found myself at Bufuja health center”;

UPDATE: attacked while harvesting crops with his mother, said “When I saw the furious relatives, I managed to escape. I thought my mother was safe and that her conversion was still hidden, only to hear one of them telling her, ‘We heard that you joined Christianity’”)

Aimuna Namutongi (aged 60, convert, mother of Malik Higenyi, attacked while harvesting crops with her son, right hand fractured, head lacerated)

Pakistan: Lahore

Sajjad Masih Gill (brother of Sarfraz Masih, sentenced to life imprisonment in Gojra district, Toba Tek Singh on [July 13, 2013](#) for allegedly sending a blasphemous text message, the

transmitting cell phone was not recovered by the police and no evidence connecting it to the accused was presented in court, the conviction and sentencing also occurred after the accuser retracted the accusation and admitted that the police had pressured him into making it; second trial for the same offense begun, defense attorneys argued that this second prosecution constituted illegal double jeopardy, judge agreed on [September 30, 2013](#) and dismissed the case; appeal underway as of [November 26, 2015](#), asked for prayers from Christians around the world; **UPDATE**: judge refused to hear his appeal because it was a blasphemy case)

Andrew Brunson (aged 48, husband of Norine Brunson, U.S. citizen, detained as a 'national security risk' on [October 7, 2016](#), denied access to U.S. diplomats, attorneys, and fellow parishioners, told he would be deported; transferred on [October 20, 2016](#) to another detention center; **UPDATE**: ordered held on 'terrorism' allegations from a 'secret informant', attorney denied access to the allegations)

Thailand: Bangkok

Maqsood Iqbal (described the detention of Pakistani Christian asylum seekers, all had their UN High Commissioner for Refugee ID cards seized, said "This morning 45 people were captured and were taken as detainees. I have been there with them from the start till the end. i have seen everything with my sinful eyes. Within those 45 people are 23 Children, 13 Women and 9 men some of them are of old age. It was unbearable for me to see the people crying out for help. As you already know Christmas month has just begun and we are targeted like this after coming here, trying to escape persecution in Pakistan. Now if the fine are not be paid the entire group of asylum seekers will be thrown into criminal jails. So as a brother I ask you to help them in this time of need. May God bless you")

Nigeria: Kafanchan, Kaduna state

Catholic bishops issued a pastoral letter *Enough of the Bloodshed* regarding continued Muslim herdsmen attacks "If anything, government has shown outright partisanship in favor of the herdsmen to the disappointment of the majority Southern Kaduna indigenes and Christians. This is what lends credence to our earlier assertion and belief that there is a well-planned Jihad against our people with the sole aim of conquering our people and occupying our land...In most of these attacks, the military stands aloof and watches while our people are being massacred. The viciousness of these self-styled Jihadists sends shivers into the spines of our traumatized people"

Sts Peter and Paul church was attacked by a suicide bomber during the Divine Liturgy right after the reading of the Gospel, 28 were killed [several days later] and 64 wounded

Nabil Habib (aged 45, father of newborn son Fady and two girls, brother of Zarif Habib, church security guard, attempted to stop the bomber, **killed**)

Dr Nevin Adel Salama (aged 31, obstetrics and gynecology specialist, Coptic language expert, **killed**)

Nevin Nabil Youssef (aged 30, **killed**)

Sabah Wadih Yassa (aged 62, mother of Raymon Wadih, mother-in-law of Basma Sulaiman, grandmother of Thomas, Avon, and Giovanni, **killed**)

Sohair Mahrous (aged 60, **killed**)

Verena Emad Amin (aged 18, daughter of Emad Tawil and Madeleine Tawfiq Hanna, sister of Peter Tawil, **killed**, had a premonition in November 2016 that she boarded a "train of death")

Veronaa Fahim Helmy (aged 18, sister of Marina Fahim Helmy, **killed**)

Widad Wahba (**killed**)

Angel Marcus (aged 40, injured, hospitalized)

Odette Saleh (aged 63, injured, hospitalized)

Lorise Naguib (aged 62, injured, hospitalized)

Magy Momen (aged 10, fourth grade student, Scout, volleyball player, ballerina, actor, injured, hospitalized in critical condition with shrapnel in her brain, has not been responding to treatment)

Heba (daughter of Amal "Souad" Atta Bishara, hospitalized in critical condition)

Thomas (aged 8, son of Raymon Wadih and Basma Sulaiman, hospitalized with shrapnel in his face and head)

Samiha Tawfik (wife of Qelliny Farag, present near the explosion, condition not reported)

Cynthia Michel (aged 14, hospitalized, recovering from surgery, said that just before the explosion "I was very surprised to see a man with something on his head and a big belly walking into the church in the women's section. Then he opened his jacket, and after that I did not see or hear anything")

Avon (aged 4, daughter of Raymon Wadih and Basma Sulaiman, has suffered from post-traumatic stress)

Stephen (aged 6, son of Eman Youssef, survived uninjured, now orphaned)

Saber Milad (church security guard, survived)

Marian (daughter of Nabil Habib, later said: "We had breakfast together, and we were joking with each other. He was exceptionally happy that day", her father sent her home after the first liturgy to make tea: "I had just started the water cooker when I heard a big explosion. I thought of my father immediately. There was white smoke everywhere, and people were running around in panic. I was in shock, but I managed to run outside. I started asking everyone if they'd seen my father...He was just lying there, still holding tight to the keys of the church, even though the explosion had blown him meters away. I put his head on my lap. He gave me the keys and asked me to take care of my younger brother and sister. Then he closed his eyes and smiled peacefully, his face shining. Then he went to heaven...I go to church now each Sunday, my faith has grown. I don't know what tomorrow will bring, but I do know that God will take care of me. I have felt God's incredible comfort through these times. And I've felt the warm love of the Christian community. God takes, but He gives back more. I can't repeat it enough, and I want the young adults around the world to know it as well. God is love. God is kind. God is merciful. I have experienced this in my most difficult hour")

Wagdi Wageh (widower of Amany Saad Aziz, said "I was attending the Liturgy with my wife as usual. Suddenly we heard a huge explosion, the lights went off and the ceiling on the women's side of the church collapsed. I rushed over to search for my wife. Rubble, dust and broken wood of the pews covered most of the bodies. I only recognized her by her clothing - her face was covered with blood and dust...The day before the bombing, my wife felt that she would soon die: she was acting as if to say goodbye. My sister phoned us and said she would like to come to visit, my wife replied, 'Wait for tomorrow and you will attend my funeral'. On Saturday evening, my wife also prepared a present, gave it to

my mother and told her 'this is to remember me by'...Although I feel great pain, I'm sure that she is in a very good place in Heaven. She was always praying, reading in the Bible and going to church. Pray for us")

Magdi Ramzi (aged 59, said "I realized from the shrieks, the many people running around me and those crying out in pain, that it was an explosion. I thought I was going to die, that it was the end of the world", cried about a relative "She's probably dead, she must be dead. Oh God! We were just praying!", daughter hospitalized, daughter-in-law and two grandchildren survived, the one year old 's clothing was stained with his daughter's blood)

Emad Tawil (aged 53, widower of Madeleine Tawfiq Hanna, father of Peter Tawil and Verena Emad Amin, plastics factory operator, later said "Every time they bomb a church or attack us, they increase our faith", has been having chest pains since the attack, pointed heavenward and said "I want to go")

Peter Tawil (aged 21, son of Emad Tawil and Madeleine Tawfiq Hanna, brother of Verena Emad Amin, carried his sister from the church before she died "I was carrying my sister and she was saying, 'Help me!' and I couldn't help")

Nadia Salah (aged 33, widow of Nabil Habib, mother of Fadi)

Attiya Mahrous (church worker, said "I found bodies, many of them women, lying on the pews. It was a horrible scene")

Mariam Shenouda (said "I saw a headless woman being carried away. Everyone was in a state of shock. We were scooping up people's flesh off the floor. There were children. What have they done to deserve this? I wish I had died with them instead of seeing these scenes")

Emad Shoukry (said "As soon as the priest called us to prepare for prayer, the explosion happened. The explosion shook the place...The dust covered the hall and I was looking for the door, although I couldn't see anything... I managed to leave in the middle of screams and there were a lot of people thrown on the ground")

Qelliny Farag (aged 80, husband of Samiha Tawfik, said "I could not see anything, everything turned black suddenly...We were all in shock, covered in dust, running through corpses that got thrown by the intensity of the blast. A minute passed by and I started to see flesh scattered everywhere around us. Even the ceiling had collapsed")

Noureen Grace (sister-in-law of Madeline Michelle, said "She was completely destroyed. I spoke to her only yesterday. We spoke every day")

Tahani Gabriel (aged 65, cousin of Amal "Souad" Atta Bishara, said "The [church] turnout was bigger than normal" due to a memorial for her cousin's husband)

Tadros Zaki (aged 63, said "It was terrifying. Things were falling down on us. I couldn't get down from behind the altar because of the smoke")

Kamel Hanna (witnessed the attack, said at least 10 women were killed [the actual number of women was 22] "We were about to pray when the explosion occurred. My friends and I were outside because the church was full of faithful. There was blood everywhere")

Fr Antonios Mounir (had been celebrating the Liturgy at the time of the explosion, said "The door next to the main entrance was the easiest for the bomber. No one saw him, neither

the deacons, nor the volunteers who work for the church", added that he had he had met the attacker the day before during an apparent reconnaissance of the church "[He said he was] buying books. Since there were no books in that room, he asked to go and pray in the church but his request was denied")

Amin Mohamed Mowafy (cleaner, survived the [December 31, 2011](#) church bombing in [Alexandria](#); **UPDATE**: survived the Sts Peter and Paul church bombing, said he will never forget the sights of the two bombings for the rest of his life)

Fr Mikhail Anton (said of Dr Nevin Adel Salama "Nevin worked as an Obstetrics and Gynecology doctor in Sheikh Zayed hospital in Cairo. She was single and was an active servant of the church, she taught the Coptic language and was loved by all the church members. She was kind and humble and had a strong relationship with God. She lived like an angel on the earth, loved all people and a smile was never absent from her face. She was always talking about martyrs and she hoped to be like them. Those who were martyred in this incident moved from the Liturgy on the earth to the Liturgy on heaven to complete their prayer with Jesus Christ")

Bishop Suriel (said "Today has been one of the most difficult days of my life. Hearing about such barbaric events on the news or watching them on television is one thing but experiencing them firsthand is something else altogether...Walking up to the Church of St Peter in the Cathedral complex and seeing from afar that the roof has blown out made me think, "O My Lord, what lies ahead inside the Church then???" What I saw on Ramsis Street made me realize that this is a huge disaster of gigantic proportions. The number of police on the street and the number of protesters who were very sad and chanting...It was then that I entered the church with some difficulty due to the large crowds. Nothing could prepare me for what I saw next. It was complete pandemonium...My heart dropped and I could not stop crying from what I was seeing. Then I saw the clock on the wall which had stopped at 9:57 am, the time of the bombing exactly. This moment in time will always be embedded in my mind and heart forever. It is the moment when we gained new martyrs in 2016 and new intercessors on our behalf in front of the throne of God...I began to try to imagine what it would have been like to be praying in that church this morning. A Sunday morning, families going to celebrate liturgy during the beginning of the holy month of Kiahk before the Feast of Nativity, days that are full of joy. Then moments later the church looks like this? Tears ran down my face, my heart was weeping blood for the families that are suffering and have lost loved ones. Many mothers had lost their lives as the bomb was on the right side of the church where women stand...I looked at the roof that had blown out and I could see the heavens and asked myself, O Lord of heavens, why have you forsaken Your people? Why have you allowed for this tragedy to befall your beloved people of Egypt? Why Lord? I do not understand. Even if my mind cannot comprehend, I will always accept Your will and say "Thy will be done")

Tran Thi Hong (wife of Pastor Nguyen Cong Chinh, taken from her home by police on [April 14, 2016](#) after she refused to answer questions concerning her [March 30, 2016](#) conversation with U.S. diplomats, beaten at the police station in [Pleiku, Gia Lai province](#), returned and dumped unconscious in the road in front of her home; taken by police at 6 AM on [May 13, 2016](#) along with her 18 year old son [leaving her other children unattended], abused for 3 hours which including having chopsticks forced into her mouth, released, her son was released later that day; **UPDATE**: arrived at Phuoc Co jail, Vung Tau, after waiting 3 hours in the rain was told her husband had been moved to another prison)

We had already pleaded guilty. The final judgement was passed on 18 May and we were sentenced to three years’ imprisonment with hard labor or a fine of \$150 each”)

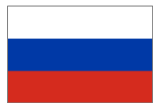

Zhang Kai (civil rights attorney; disappeared in [Wenzhou, Zhejiang province](#) on [August 25, 2015](#), apparently detained in response to his defense of churches during the cross removal campaign; reported as of [August 31, 2015](#) to have has been sentenced to 6 months' imprisonment for 'endangering national security' and 'gathering a crowd to disturb public order', denied legal representation due to the national security charge, has been held in a 'black' jail outside of the normal judicial review, had said "I've made up my mind: the most they can do is jail me. But if I stay silent, I'll regret it my whole life"; appeared on Chinese television on [February 26, 2016](#) where he confessed "Such religion cases are sensitive, they can lift my fame quickly and bring some economic interest. Foreign countries also focus on the cases, it also improves my fame overseas"; reported on [March 23, 2016](#) to have been released from the 'black jail', has returned to his home; posted a statement on the internet on [August 30, 2016](#) "With a Christian faith and a free conscience, I am officially stating that the interview with a number of media...over the trial of Zhou Shifeng was against my own will...My elderly parents were living in fear and worry during the six months of detention. [I was] powerless to resist the pressure imposed by a strong regime...I am willing to confess to God for weakness and fear in my heart and spirit and I ask the forgiveness of other family members of 709" [709 is the name of the group of dissidents and Christians, derived from the number detained in mid-2015], the statement was quickly removed, fled his parents' home [in [Hohhot, Inner Mongolia](#)] before it was surrounded by police, on the run; **UPDATE** arrested)

Han (described an attack by gang members who were hired by government officials in an attempt to force a church to close so that it could be seized without adequate compensation "My son and his friend went out to eat, and, when they had finished eating, came out [of the restaurant]. Seven or eight gangsters surrounded them, dragged them from the car and beat them up. His friend was injured so badly that he could barely open his eyes. He was bleeding profusely, and his nose bridge was fractured. The police came out after I reported the case, but they colluded with the gangsters. We went to the police

station and recorded the incident, but nothing was done about it. On the next day, several church elders went to the municipal government to petition...We are prepared to petition the provincial government,” Han said. “First of all, we are not violating any laws. Secondly, we are defending our legal rights. The believers are not afraid of any consequences, even death. Today, the brothers, sisters, and leaders from every church throughout the Langfang area came to support us, promising that they would accompany us even to Beijing. We have about six or seven thousand believers now”)

United Kingdom: Windsor

Wesley Richards (chairman of the management board at The King's House School, said "We were criticized for our safeguarding, whilst [Ofsted] inspectors are allowed to interview our children behind closed doors, without a teacher present and without parental consent. We were unable to verify what questions were asked or the manner in which they were put to the children. Our teachers are required to leave doors ajar or blinds up if they happen to be the only adult present - something Ofsted does not practice...Ofsted is operating without accountability and undermines the 'British values' it promotes, by failing to show respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs, in this case, Christian", added that the inspector said to teachers on [December 16-18, 2016](#) "Do you teach about other religions or do you pretend they don't exist?" and was overheard on the phone to say "I think I can nail this one on progress in reading and writing alone")
