Teymur Sultan ogly Akhmedov (aged 60, husband, father of three sons, arrested on [January 18, 2017](#) for sharing his religious beliefs with KNB secret police informants, held in pre-trial detention, denied cancer treatment; **UPDATE**: motion to terminate his case denied, reportedly has been beaten in prison, can barely walk)

Uganda

Hassan Muwanguzi (convert; arrested in [Kabuna village, Budaka district](#) on [February 26, 2017](#) on abduction and human sacrifice charges after a convert from Islam [Namusisi Budadu Birye] took refuge with him in [2015](#) after her father beat her, said “I brought Namusisi into my house after receiving messages that she was badly beaten, and that she needed support due to her newly founded faith in Christ. But now I am falsely charged and being threatened by many Muslims who want to kill me because of the message that has gone all over that I am kidnapping and sacrificing people’s lives in the name of converting them to Christianity”; **UPDATE**: still in custody despite the appearance of Namusisi Budadu Birye before police on [February 27, 2017](#), expects to be released soon)

Issaf Sameh (aged 10, grandson of Saad Hana, described how his grandfather and uncle were killed, also said “They stole from the flat and set fire to it”)

Kirollos (maintenance man, said “In the past we used to try to reassure ourselves, but we started to be terrified since last week, when they began to kill people inside their homes. I don’t know when we can go home, and I can’t be sure if I go back that they won’t return”)

Mary (civil servant, said “I am scared they will rob and burn my home. It represents my work for 30 years and that of my father before me. If it were up to me I would go back because they don’t kill women, but I am afraid for my two sons”)

Jordan: al-Um-Kundun

Fr Khalil Jaar (**UPDATE**: commented on the reduction of international aid for Iraqi and Syrian refugees "The situation of Iraqi Christians refugees is critical and dangerous. They have finished their money and they aren't allowed to work. How can they live in human dignity?...At any month we might have to close the school, because we don't have the money to run it. Everything is gratis for the children: transportation, uniforms, school supplies. I hope our good friends can help")

Ra'ed Bahou (regional director of the Pontifical Mission, said "This is now the third year of displacement for the Iraqi Christians. It's very tough. Donations are becoming less, while global attention is waning. That means that more problems will be created for these Iraqis. We are trying our best to help them with health care, education, housing and logistics. But the problem is bigger than us")

Omar Abawi (Caritas Jordan program manager)

Wael Suleiman (director of Caritas Jordan; **UPDATE**: said of the refugees "I am always struck by their desperate words about losing hope and the miserable conditions they live under: frustration, loneliness, isolation, despair and sadness over their forced exodus from their country, families, history, current situation and future...We are here to heal the wounds, lift the morales, help to restore hope, enhance human relationships and reflect the concept of living as one human family")

Adel Munir (father of Munir Munir and Dimiana, civil servant, found his name on an ISIL execution list, sprayed with acid by neighbors, fled his home in el-Arish)

Munir Munir (son of Adel Munir, said "The police and army cannot do anything; they cannot even protect themselves. Of course we won't go back to Arish. Go back to die?")

Dimiana (daughter of Adel Munir, said "Our neighbors took our land because we are Christian. They tried to attack me and my sister and when my father came to defend us they sprayed his face with acid")

Sameh Kamel (husband, father of two, fled his home in el-Arish an hour before ISIL gunmen arrived at his home, said "They're knocking on doors, and if they find a Christian, they kill him")

Egypt

Ishaq Ibrahim (**UPDATE**: said "What we are seeing here [in Sinai] is new. There has always been violence against Christians, but it was usually for a 'reason' like land disputes. Now Christians are killed just for being Christians. Militants are sending the government a message, saying they can change part of the country's demographics. This is a dangerous precedent.. .And who knows if it will be replicated in Upper Egypt or elsewhere")

Christians were detained for praying for the National People's Congress and the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference, both were deported to their home provinces

Zhou Jinxia (**UPDATE**: said "Today is the opening of a conference between the NPC and the CPPCC, and we wished to pray for our compatriots, the attendees of the conference, and the country itself with the hope that our nation will be blessed with peace and freedom. Sister Shi Xinhong was stopped on the way to the Great Hall. I left her and continued on. I called her later in the day and realized that she had been seized by the police, who questioned Sister Shi about my whereabouts from the other side of the phone. With Sister Shi in their hands, [the police] searched for half an hour and failed to locate me. I proceeded, but the Hall was heavily guarded and there was no way for me to get in. I abandoned the prayer I prepared earlier on the street")

Bishop Botros Aziz is still banned from accessing the village. Thus I proposed that all worshippers gather at one of the people's homes to perform the Liturgy there, so as to prevent strife. We await actions by security to resolve the problem and confirm the sovereignty of government as well as citizenship rights")

But while no country can be fully secure, I think there's will on government side to act decisively against these constant attempts to destabilize Egypt")

The family are known to me and been receiving pastoral support from me since last August")

Wilson Chowdhry (Chairman of the British Pakistani Christian Association, said "Paucity of evidence [in asylum applications] is not a surprise to the BPCA. In our opinion when you flee a country seeking refuge the last thing you want to do is go to local police for

evidence of your imprisonment and few people video every moment of their lives. Sadly despite increasing evidence of the hatred meted out towards Christians in Pakistan, most western nations ignore their plight. This has meant thousands are stranded in countries such as Thailand, Malaysia and Sri Lanka where visa restrictions are more lax and tourism visas are notably inexpensive. For this victims life has a constant threat of capture and detainment and they are vigorously exploited working for almost nothing just to get some food on their table")

Christians reported on the persecution by ISIL in the Sinai

S E (fled al-Arish, said "To date, at least three towns are completely emptied of their Copt inhabitants: Rafah, near the border with the Gaza Strip, Cheikh Zowayed and al-Arish. Unfortunately, the state only heard our cries of pain when it was already too late")

Imad Gad (Member of Parliament, **UPDATE:** said "The government has not reacted quickly and effectively in the face of this catastrophe. Why have they allowed terror to go so long unpunished?")

Kamal Zakher (**UPDATE:** said "The Copts in al-Arish are the responsibility of the Egyptian state, not of the Church. Ensuring their protection is a duty and a right clearly expressed in the Constitution")

Soliman Chafik (said "The Egyptian army leads a fierce and all-out war against terrorism in Sinai, as far as it has been dubbed 'the province of the Islamic State' in July 2011. A conflict that caused 1,034 deaths among soldiers and dozens of Bedouin casualties. Despite everything, when terrorists are attacked their response is to automatically target Copts")

They had planned to go and buy jewelry together the following day; and she had just bought new clothes for her cousin's wedding on Sunday"; **UPDATE:** reported that he had been informed by the police that the national security services had issued his sister a new ID card which stated that her religion was Islam, family protested her abduction outside the national security service headquarters and was then attacked by officers, said "They broke the leg of my 23-year-old brother and wounded my older brother, Amir, who's 28, [they] dragged my mother and beat my three aunts")

Why are you Christian?' I told him that everyone is on their religion, and nobody leaves their religion...I do not want to become one like you,' I told him. He asked 'why? What is wrong with me?' I told him 'you don't say your prayers, you kill humans, you earn haram [sinful] earning, and you harass people.' He said, 'me?' I said 'yes,' He said no. I said yes, 'I swear to God.'", was not harmed for her outspokenness)

Aniseh Marqus (wife of Jamil for 57 years, refugee from [Batma](#), fled from ISIL in [2015](#), reported to have said "They bombed the church in our neighborhood and destroyed everything around it. My home was nearby so naturally it was destroyed too. I wish I could return home, but I have no home left really")

Kim Davis (aged 51, Rowan county clerk, jailed on [September 3, 2015](#) for contempt of court for refusing to issue same sex marriage licenses, court denied her request to remove her pro forma signature from the licenses, still being held despite the fact her office has complied with the law by issuing licenses, appeal underway; released on [September 8, 2015](#); a suit against her by the American Civil Liberties Union was declared moot on [April 19, 2016](#) after the state legislature passed legislation granting her the accommodation she sought; **UPDATE**: a Federal judge denied the American Civil Liberties Union claim that she pay their court costs totaling \$231,000 because their suit against her did not prevail)

We condemn similar events that have taken place in recent days, whether or not related to what happened recently in Florencio Varela")

Bishop Narayan Sharma (**UPDATE:** said "Because Christians have no other way to put their dead bodies, they bury the dead person on their own private land. And in such cases, nearby neighbors and the community, they come up, and the next day they want the buried dead body to be taken out and put somewhere else...Though the government recognized the Christian community in Nepal and our Constitution gives equal rights to all religious communities in Nepal, still we struggle with [the issue of] the graveyard," adds Sharma. "We don't know, after our death, where we will be taken for burial, where our bodies will be laid. We are still negotiating with the government, but so far there is no clue [as to what the government has done], no solution")

Leela Bhakt Pradhan (said “[A few years ago], Shyam Nepali, a new believer who lived in Dolaghat area, died two months after accepting Christ. We buried his body on a private land that was owned by a believer. But after that, all the villagers came and objected to it. So we had to dig up his grave and walk about 3 miles with the body to bury him again on another private land belonging to a believer”)

Joshua Magrati (cemetery secretary, said “The biggest challenge is the road that leads to this cemetery. It’s about two miles from the main road. We have spent about 2.5 million Nepali rupees [US\$24,000], and yet it’s far from being complete. However, we have already buried two bodies here...In Kathmandu, there was a piece of land inside the complex of the Pashupatinath Temple, which allowed Christians to be buried. But they blocked that area for Christian burials [in 2011]. There was another cemetery in Lele area, but political parties incited villagers to object to burials there. So we can no longer use that land”)

Ang Dawa Sherpa (cemetery secretary, said “There is no other Christian cemetery near Kathmandu. There is one in Pokhara, and one in Chitawan. They are far from here”)

Parshuram Sunchuri (cemetery board member, said “We chose this place because of two reasons. One, we wanted a place that was really far from any human habitation, as opposition comes mainly from local communities near a Christian graveyard. Two, the nearer the land to the city, the more expensive it is”)

Fr Maurice Kweirang (**UPDATE:** reported to have said of the worsening refugee problem: The Church is not able to feed them because we have limited capabilities and we cannot extend our support to all the IDPs outside the camp. We provide food once a week to those living in host communities, and others living on their own. 3856 households are receiving our weekly food distribution, regardless of their religious background. I alerted some humanitarian organizations asking if they could assist. But they said they have moved away from ‘emergency support’ to ‘livelihood’ in neighboring Borno State...Our team went out recently to assess the situation. They visited some IDPs who returned back to their communities, but only found that most of them are emaciated and looking unwell. Both adults and children show acute signs of acute malnutrition. We brought some of them to our clinics for medical treatment, but we couldn’t keep them. They are living with relations in Yola and in surrounding communities. The church has written to donors for support. But for now we haven’t yet received any response”, also spoke of Nigerian refugees being expelled from Cameroon: “It’s difficult to give an exact figure of those ‘returnees’. I only saw the first batch: they are about 10,000. The second batch is yet to be confirmed but it will be higher than 10,000. There are still others – over 60,000 – trapped in northern Cameroon”)

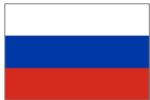
