Pastor Li Mutian (ordered by the Religious Affairs Bureau and the DSPPS on [March 23, 2017](#) to 'suspend all gatherings' of his church, refused; **UPDATE**: officers returned and told church members they would be criminally liable should they continue to meet)

Pakistan: Sheikhpura, Punjab province

Ansar Masih (aged 21, son of Nasreen Bibi, brother of Samina Bibi, abducted by the family of a Muslim woman he had befriended, stripped, beaten and tortured until unconscious, dumped at his family's home, hospitalized, moved to a specialized burn unit, said "I am still traumatized by the attack and am too scared to leave my home. The men hurt me so bad, they kicked, me punched me, bit me, spat at me, hit me with bars and then burnt me after I first watched them heat the poles they had beaten me with in their fireplace. I was simply a friend of Jameela we did not have any physical affair, but this family simply hate Christians and have enacted such brutality on me because to them I am just like rubbish. I lost consciousness during the burning and then found myself in hospital. I am still in pain and will be scarred for life but at least I am alive. God preserved my life and I will stay forever indebted to him")

Samina Bibi (aged 30, sister of Ansar Masih, filed a police report after her brother was abducted and tortured, police have detained only one assailant)

Nasreen Bibi (aged 50, mother of Ansar Masih, said "My son's life is precious to me, he has undergone brutality the likes of which I have never seen before. I am still shocked by the violence that he has survived and thank God that he is recovering. The men that hurt him so bad deserve to be punished and I am praying God will bring justice into this situation as it happens to so many young Christian men")

Egypt: Naja Rizq Shenouda hamlet, Tahta district, Sohag province

Bishop Asheiya (wrote in a newly published letter “The Copts of Naja Rizq Shenouda have suffered since 1971 on account of the refusal of the local authorities to grant them a permit to build a church on a 618sq.m plot of land owned by the Church and officially registered as Church property. There is no church in the hamlet which is home to some 3,500 Copts, the Copts worship in a rundown building — if it can be termed ‘building’ — that has no ceiling and thus no privacy and is moreover unshielded against weather conditions”)

Youssef Sidhoum (editor of the Coptic newspaper al-Watani; **UPDATE**: wrote that the church building license was referred to provincial security by the governor in January 2017 in violation of the 2016 Law for Building and Restoring Churches)

Venezuela: Caracas and Merida

Church leaders spoke out after the national legislature was dissolved

Cardinal Jorge Urosa Savino (**UPDATE:** said "The National Assembly is still blocked. I am deeply concerned about the state of emergency in our country regarding poor economic growth which has persisted for the past twelve months. This situation is not normal. Neither are other measures such as the annulment of the revocatory referendum and postponement of elections for governors. This creates a situation of dictatorship")

Cardinal Baltazar Enrique Porras Cardozo (**UPDATE:** said "corrections to sentences are simply cosmetic changes which do not resolve the situation, since they fail to recognize the National Assembly as an autonomous body thus confusing the people. We continue to uphold valid the request made by Cardinal Parolin, last year, to restore the regular function of Parliament... If parliament is to be accused, it must be the people who decide, however at the moment, the real needs of the people are food and medicine")

Prof Anjum James Paul (**UPDATE:** appeared before the Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority [PEMRA] with documentation concerning the television drama 'Baji Irshad' depiction of Christians "There is desecration of religious symbol as there are vulgar dialogues wearing holy Cross. There is racial discrimination as well because there are nick names like Kala Joseph [black Joseph], Peeno, Meedan, Chitti etc...Only Christians in the drama have been presented as non-serious, inferior, beggars, thieves, greedy, without etiquettes, superstitious, scandalizing their daughters, disrespecting parents, disrespecting husband, disrespecting mother...and love affairs but Muslims have been presented very decent and well-mannered. Only Christians have been presented doing menial jobs...Only Christians have been presented uneducated as they wrongly speak Urdu and English language. But it is strange that when they speak with any Muslim then

no wrong pronunciation. The biased writer has deliberately ignored the true picture of Christians who have been torch bearers in education, health, defense and many other fields", the PEMRA officials showed little interest in his presentation)

Nigeria

Kwamkur Samuel (Director of Legal and Public Affairs, Christian Association of Nigeria, reported to have written a letter to the DSS [Department of State Services] protesting the detention of four CAN leaders: “Regrettably, despite assurances from your operatives, led by the Director of Operations, who said that the invitation was only to interact with these distinguished Nigerian Christians and to seek their opinion and advice on how to address the lingering ethno-religious crises in Nigeria, it turned out that the main reason behind the invitation was your interest in the video jingle produced by CAN...to raise funds for the support of the Church and distressed Christians in Nigeria. It was shocking to hear from your establishment that these materials were made to incite violence in response to the attempted annihilation of the Church in Southern Kaduna. With all due respect, such analysis and conclusion were vexatious and very wrong. Unfortunately, you ignored our request while also insisting that the persons invited should report to your Head Office as a matter of extreme urgency, individually and on different dates. The most worrisome and reprehensible aspect of the whole exercise is that these respectable Nigerians, with the exception of General Dogonyaro, were compelled to write statements 'under caution' as if they were common criminals”)

Australia: Bankstown

Mike (aged 30, assaulted on a train by four Muslim men who ripped off his cross and stomped on it while saying "F*** Jesus", punched and kicked in the face, back and shoulders, girlfriend hit and kicked by two Muslim women, five uniformed transit officers watched but did nothing other than to call police who met the train at the next stop where they took statements, said "I've always worn my cross. For him to rip it off and step on it has to be a religious crime")

Rev George Capsis (has warned Christians to not wear religious symbols in Muslim enclaves, said: "This is not an isolated incident. There are gangs of these young fellows of Muslim background who have been harassing people they identify as Christian...You don't hear about it because no one's reporting it")

Central African Republic: Ngaoundaye

Fr Aurelio Gazzera OCD (**UPDATE:** said "...a group of former Seleka rebels entered the village, ransacking homes, and the two missions in the area, that of the Capuchin Fathers and that of the Polish religious of the Sisters of Divine Charity of Saint Giovanna Antida Thouret. There seems to have been at least four deaths. Thanks to the intervention of MINUSCA [UN Mission in Central Africa] the militiamen withdrew...Some of our mission nuns who were going to the border with a van found the road blocked by thirty armed men, who forced them to follow them as they entered the village...This is a small village which lies at the border of the Central African Republic with Chad and Cameroon, in the extreme northwest of the Country... The sisters told me that the bandits were well armed, but were not molested ...Until substantial forces of MINUSCA peacekeepers and soldiers of the regular army are deployed, the north-west border area will remain in the hands of various armed groups created by former Seleka and their anti-Balaka rivals")

He built houses for all his workers, he built a church, he made provision for schools. It is obvious that for him Jesus and justice were two sides of the one coin. To drop Easter from Cadbury's Easter Egg Hunt in my book is tantamount to spitting on the grave of Cadbury", Cadbury denied involvement in the removal)

Marshall Polston (suspended from college on [March 24, 2017](#) after he challenged a Muslim's professor's class statement that Christianity was false and a Muslim student's advocacy of Sharia punishment of homosexuals; reinstated on [March 30, 2017](#) after his professor filed a false police report alleging violation of her restraining order against him and he proved with credit card receipts and security video that he was in a restaurant with his grandfather in another town at the time; **UPDATE**: the professor withdrew her restraining order)

India: Jadhua village, Bihar state

Pastor Sikandar Kumar (aged 45, attacked along with his congregation by Hindu radicals on [February 10, 2017](#); **UPDATE**: lured from his home by a boy on a bicycle, severely beaten by Hindu radicals, lost his hearing due to neurological damage)

Pastor Arun Kumar (**UPDATE**: described the attack on Pastor Sikandar Kumar “When the pastor stepped out [of his home], 15 men started beating him and accused him of conversions in the village. They badgered his head with iron swords and sticks. Pastor Sikandar fell down unconscious: he had a deep injury on his head. He was bleeding severely”, has assumed pastoral leadership in Pastor Sikandar Kumar's absence, has received death threats, added "More than 100 families attend the church. The police have provided us security for the Sunday worship")

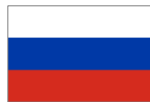

Pastor Yahana Madai (church service disrupted by a 9 year old Muslim girl on [November 10, 2014](#); arrested on [November 11, 2014](#) after the girl's father alleged that he had touched her breast and removed her veil when he stopped her disruptions the previous night, released the next day, case closed a few days later due to lack of evidence; charges refiled in [early March 2017](#); **UPDATE**: charges dismissed, rearrested on unspecified charges while leaving the courthouse)

Mexico: Ciudad Juarez

Pastor Chito Aguilar (aged 62, former drug trafficker, said "...eight people walk into a church, one or two will remain at the doors and the others will start collecting watches, rings, wallets...everything. So they become an easy target of the attackers...Seven years ago, the situation was very difficult in Ciudad Juarez. Lots of pastors were kidnapped, their children killed. It seems like for four years we had a period of calm, but in the last year the violence has started increasing again. Pastors are starting to be extorted, leaders threatened with kidnapping, and I believe that among the pastors there is fear because of what we lived and experienced seven or eight years ago")

Adrian Lara (church musician, said "The city of Juarez has been known around the world because the violence has been really hard. Today, in 2017, it's less prevalent. But in 2012, it was very terrible. Every businessman was called by people, who said: 'If you don't pay, we are going to kill your children, or burn your house. We are going to do many things to you if you don't pay'")

Rasnius Pasaribu (church secretary; **UPDATE**: reported to have said "Such protests [against their new church construction] challenge our efforts to maintain diversity. No matter what. We will celebrate Holy Week in a shophouse where we have been holding Sunday services. We will work with police and local people to guard the celebrations")

Indonesia: Bogor, West Java

Rev Abdi Saragih (**UPDATE**: reported to have said of Holy Week celebrations "We have no other place [to meet other than their closed building]. We will hold the celebrations in the house even though there might be protests...It is not easy being a Christian. Carrying a cross is our task")

Indonesia: Parung Panjang

Tyas Utomo (parish council deputy chairman, reported to have said Holy Week celebrations will be in a tent "as this is the only facility we have...We cannot guarantee that Easter celebrations will be safe as there is potential threat")

A suicide bomber attacked a church during the Divine Liturgy, killing 30 and wounding 78

Fr Bishoy Wadie (present during the attack, survived)

Fr Daniel Maher (father of Deacon Beshoy Maher, said “In just seconds, the entire church was filled with smoke, fire, blood, and screams...He was like an angel, standing in the middle of the deacons singing”)

Deacon Beshoy Maher (aged 23, son of Fr Daniel Maher, **killed**)

Emil Edward (brother of Edmond Edward, wounded in the head, hospitalized)

Wahby Lamie (one nephew was killed in the bombing and one injured, said “How much longer are we going to be this divided? Anyone who’s different from them now is an infidel, whether they’re Muslim or Christian. They see them as infidels. How much longer are these people going to exist?”)

Madeleine (housewife, said “I saw a blue light on the belt of a person who was next to the deacons, then the explosion took place”)

Edmond Edward (brother of Emil, said “After the explosion, everything became dark from the smoke. There was a clear lapse in security, which must be tightened from now on to save lives”)

Susan Mikhail (apartment across the street shaken in the blast, said “Deacons were the first to run out of the church. Many of them had blood on their white robes”)

Deacon Magdy George Youssef (aged 58, thrown under a pew by the explosion, said “All I could think of was to find my wife, and all I could see was smoke, blood and completely charred bodies”, later found his wife at home with burns on her face)

Deacon Rafet Habshy (cousin of Hany Ezat, injured)

Hany Ezat (cousin of Deacon Rafet Habshy, said after the explosion “As a Coptic Christian, I no longer feel safe in Egypt”)

Vivian Fareeg (said “There was a huge explosion in the hall. Fire and smoke filled the room and the injuries were extremely severe”)

Fr Youssef Sabry (said “How did this suicide bomber reach the nave? Where were the security forces who were guarding the church? How did they allow a person wearing a suicide vest to enter the church without searching him?”)

Deacon Michael Nabil Ragheb (aged 29, pharmacist, husband of Dr Sara Fekry, father of Priscilla, son of Nabil Ragheb, **killed**)

Dr Sara Fekry (widow of Michael Nabil Ragheb, said "On Palm Sunday he was actually one of those responsible for the hymns, so on Sunday morning the three of us went to the church to attend the Liturgy and celebrate the feast of Palm Sunday. Michael asked me not to sit in the front row of benches, but to sit in the back of the church and wait for him there until after the celebration. He then got dressed in his deacon clothes and started with the service. I didn't know why he asked me to do sit in the back of the church, but it was God's will, as in the middle of the service, at about 9.10am, the explosion took place. I heard the sound of a very huge explosion and the whole church shook like it was struck by a violent earthquake. Then it became dark in the building and people started to scream. For a moment, I thought it was Judgment Day, but then I got up and rushed to the front of the church, where the choir of deacons had been standing. When I got there, I saw many bodies and body parts lying in a pool of blood. It was like a massacre and I got a very big shock when I found Michael, lying on the ground in a pool of blood...My husband lived the life of heaven on the earth. He continuously prayed and read the Bible. I'm very happy for him as I know he is in a good place, with Jesus in heaven")

Priscilla (aged 3, daughter of Michael Nabil Ragheb and Dr Sara Fekry, granddaughter of Nabil Ragheb, present in the church during the explosion, no reported injuries)

Nabil Ragheb (father of Michael Nabil Ragheb and Kerolos Nabil Ragheb, said ""On Sunday morning I was surprised by one of my neighbors, who was knocking on the door of my flat, asking me where Michael and his wife were. I told her they went to Mar Girgis. She then told me that she heard about an explosion that had taken place at Mar Girgis. I immediately rushed to the church. When I arrived the street was filled with a great number of people, including police and ambulance personnel. I saw one of Michael's friends and when I asked him if he knew where Michael was, he told me that he had gone to heaven. Then I went in to the church and found my son drenched in blood...Michael was a very kind person. He had a very strong relationship with God and is now in a very good place, in heaven, where he will celebrate Easter with Christ")

Kerolos Nabil Ragheb (brother of Michael Nabil Ragheb, said “The parting of my brother is very difficult for us. At the same time, however, we are very happy for him because he met his fate and went to heaven. We, on the other hand, are still struggling in this mortal life, and our fate isn't known yet. I love him so much and I hope to be with him soon. I'm sure that he is in very good place in heaven, with the others who died because of their faith and with the Saints. I envy him. I want to say to my martyred brother: ‘I love you so much and I want to be like you’. I also want to say something to ISIL: ‘I'm ready to die

for my faith, like my brother. It's my desire to follow him in this. I'm waiting for you, so don't delay and please tell me which church you will bomb next so I can wait for you there. I look forward to meet Jesus, so please don't delay, as I wait for you")

Fr Ishak Habib (uncle of Michael Nabil Ragheb, said "Michael was very diligent. He was top of his class in university, where he graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy with distinction. He was also a graduate from the Coptic Theological College. He was successful, both in his working life and spiritual life. He was a son of the Church from childhood onwards and was a very obedient, humble and honest person. Since 2006 he served at Mar Girgis as a deacon, teaching the children in Sunday school. We are sure that he has gone to a good place, to heaven, and that comforts us")

Ashraf Ramzy (aged 25, said "My father and I still have headaches and a buzzing sound that has been in our ears since after the attack. The microphone made a really intense noise, then I was sure something was about to happen. I even thought of leaving the prayer. It was 9:05 when the bomb exploded. I was standing next to my father behind a column, and we were ten steps away from the blast. [It was] horrific...everyone was scattering around, looking for loved ones...looking for a wife or for a son. Anyone that was far from sight could have been dead...What can we do? Are we expected to stop praying? We're not going to stop praying")

Ishaq Ibrahim (Coptic activist; **UPDATE:** said "the idea is that the solution isn't in an emergency law, already existing laws could be used properly to remove discriminatory policies and hate speech...when putting the most recent attacks into context of Egypt, part of the problem is that sectarianism, whether societal or institutionalized, is not taken seriously. The state is doing nothing to fight the roots of this discrimination...There's clearly something faulty [with government policy] if in the past six months we have seen three bombings and Christians have been displaced from their homes in Arish")

Mina Thabet (**UPDATE:** said "There's a huge question mark around the state's strategy in combating terrorism. From 2011 until now, these terrorist operations have moved from the borders and hot spots like Sinai to the heart of the capital and to the cities of the Nile delta. At the same time, there's an increase in human rights violations happening on the premise that this is for the fight against terrorism. The attackers are only gaining more confidence and expertise, and developing ways by which to kill more victims each time...Now Christians are the primary targets, but no one knows who is next")

Mina Abdo (husband of Yvonne, father of Kerollos and Miriam, engineer, Kuwaiti resident, had returned for a visit, **killed**)

Kerollos (aged 11, son of Yvonne and Mina Abdo, brother of Miriam, Kuwaiti resident, injured in the explosion with shrapnel wounds to the face and right leg, hospitalized)

Yvonne (widow of Mina Abdo, mother of Kerollos and Miriam, doctor of gynecology, Kuwaiti resident, present during the attack, said "I love Egypt. I love my memories here. But I'm scared now. We will come back for visits, we must. My husband is buried here")

Miriam (aged 14, daughter of Yvonne and Mina Abdo, sister of Kerollos, Kuwaiti resident, present during the attack)

Egypt: Alexandra

A suicide bomber attacked the cathedral but did not get through the security checkpoint, 17 were killed and 41 wounded

Pope Tawadros II (**UPDATE:** was finishing the Divine Liturgy when the attack occurred, refused to move after the explosion and sat in prayer)

Rezk Helmy Kelnton (said "I saw blood stains on the church roof, 30 meters high. And I saw a man with his intestines pouring out of his body. Hands and feet scattered everywhere")

Sameh Fahim (said "I walked just 20 meters out of the church and heard the sound of a huge explosion. White dust filled the place, body parts were flying through the air, people were screaming and running in the street. One was screaming, 'My son!', another was screaming, 'My wife!', and another was screaming, 'My grandson!', as they searched for their loved ones. I saw body parts like a body without a head, it was a terrifying sight")

Fr Sergius (assistant to Pope Tawardos, said "The Church will celebrate Easter and the terrorism cannot prevent it from doing that. We will not...let them break our joy")

Patriarch Ibrahim Isaac Sidrak (aged 61; **UPDATE:** said "The day of the attacks I was in Alexandria celebrating the Divine Liturgy in our Cathedral, which stands only 200 meters away from the Copt Orthodox Cathedral. We clearly heard the loud explosion...from all over we receive requests to tighten security measures in front of churches in view of our Holy Week liturgies. And we churches have to pay the price for security services. I have no intention of accusing anyone, but many are saddened to see the same attacks time and time again, with the same method, nothing seems to change. In this situation, very often it is our lay people who offer comfort and support and hope to all. Let us pray that the Lord will demonstrate his victory and change the hearts of these murderers")

Amgad Bakheet (rickshaw driver, witnessed the suicide bomber self-detonation, hospitalized with shrapnel wounds)

Naseem Fahim (father of George Naseem Fahim, church security guard, **killed**)

George Naseem Fahim (son of Naseem Fahim, took his father's place as a church security guard after his father was killed, said "I'm continuing what he started. Why worry or be afraid? He has gone to heaven, and I am ready to join him if necessary")

Karim Ghattas (husband of Mary, injured, hospitalized)

Mary Ghattas (wife of Karim Ghattas, injured, hospitalized)

Yang Hua cried when he saw his younger son, but we didn’t cry. We were so happy and full of gratefulness and peace...Yang Hua is a new prisoner, which means that only immediate family members are allowed to visit him, and only once a month. The government is paying a lot of attention to Yang Hua. We were surrounded by police officers when we were chatting. He will stay in the [prison in Baiyun, Guiyang] for two-and-a-half months, and then he will be transferred to another prison”)

Her case has been in the doldrums due to huge pressure. There will be a strong reaction if Bibi is freed, opposing groups have made it matter of honor and ego")

Naeem Shakir (civil rights lawyer; **UPDATE**: said "Our plight is that the socio-political atmosphere of the country has no space for discussion on blasphemy laws. The judges know what is happening outside as non-state actors show their strength on the roads demanding death for [Asia] Bibi. The sensitivity surrounding blasphemy laws has made it a political tool to threaten and put down others. The state has a weak narrative regarding this law and its functionaries usually try to evade questions regarding its misuse...Such atrocities have become routine. The plight of Bibi has had a dampening effect on minorities. Their grief cannot be addressed because of religious retrogressive and extremist groups. Islamists consider her freedom a defeat for their movement")
