A minister and his family were tied up and killed by six Muslims, and their church burned to the ground, all 130 Christian converts sleeping in the church escaped but some were hospitalized

United Kingdom: Brixton

Andrea Minichiello Williams (Chief Executive of Christian Concerns, **UPDATE:** wrote regarding the case of Pastor Paul Song "...A common thread in such cases is the way in which the authorities, when exposed for their wrong doing, distort the facts [which often become 'established facts' on which unfair judgments are founded]...the Muslim Chaplain to Brixton Prison, had stated categorically to Pastor Song that he wanted to "wipe out the Christian domination" at Brixton. But for our exposure of what is going on, Christian witness within the prison may well have been wiped out...We have also spoken to numerous other Christian groups who have volunteered in Brixton for over a decade, leading Alpha courses, Christian drama courses, prayer groups and other vital ministries, only to have since been told that they can no longer continue at the prison. Some of them wish to remain anonymous out of fear, though they all tell the same story. Their courses ran smoothly until Imam Mohammed Ahmed took over as Senior Chaplain in 2015. From then on, one by one, their ministries were shut down. Different reasons were given. Some were told that there was no longer a demand for their course, despite them regularly being oversubscribed. For others, procedural minutiae prevented them from continuing. For others, Imam Mohammed Ahmed made it so clear they were no longer welcome that they felt intimidated and left...There is nothing at all to show at any point that the Imam has not simply made this up. In an atmosphere which prisoners have described as having a 'militant Muslim' feel, where we have signed statements showing that forced conversions are also happening by radicalized Muslim gangs, we should not be surprised that a radical Imam would attempt to have Pastor Song removed from Brixton...")

Pakistan: Village 77/4R, Sahiwal district, Punjab province

Pastor Cecil Daniel (church attacked, said "More than two dozen men carrying sticks forced their way into the church and beat up Christian worshippers. Women and children are among those who have been injured in the attack")

George Masih (aged 70, father of Babar, beaten while supervising the construction of a wall around his church)

Babar Masih (aged 22, son of George Masih, beaten with an axe, hospitalized)

William Masih (son of George Masih, beaten, hospitalized)

Mubarak Masih (human rights activist, said "Although this was a matter of personal enmity, the attackers found it convenient to enter the church and beat up worshippers. The village has

around 200 Christian families who are confined to their homes over fear of further violence")

Sami Minhas (chairman of the Muthida [United] Christian Movement in Sahiwal, said "The incident took place during a worship service but the police are treating it as a land dispute between two parties...[Christians] are also told that if they would seek filing of blasphemy charges against the perpetrators, then blasphemy cases would be filed against them as well, as there had been requests [to do so] from local mosques")

Aftab Gill (Christian Masiha Millat Party [MMP], **UPDATE:** said "The attacks have become so frequent that it has become difficult to keep count. The Punjab government has failed in its constitutional duty to protect the rights of Christians living in the province")

Life is relatively normal in Bangui...Since the dissolution of the Seleka movement and the anti-Balaka movement at least 14 factions have emerged that continuously clash with each other for the control of the territory and mineral and natural resources [gold, uranium, timber]. This creates a climate of general insecurity that has serious consequences on the civilian population")

A state Church wedded to a state that hates Christian virtue and Christian ethics: a state that has begun to criminalize Christian witness as hate speech, where police arrest street preachers and have them thrown in prison at the push of a SJW's phone button: a state that has begun preparations to remove children from their Christian homes if social workers detect what they improperly label 'homophobia' in the parents: a state where Christian teachers are expelled and sacked if they do not endorse the secular brainwashing on the fluidity of gender...Faced with this kind of state, it does not require a subtle reading of Scripture to observe that the gap between the world and Church has grown wide and fierce in our generation. Archbishop Aloysius Sudarso SCJ (condemned the vandalism of a newly consecrated chapel "Last March 4 I had blessed the new chapel situated in a village in an isolated area, a three-hour journey from the parish. It was a celebration in an atmosphere of supreme cordiality, with the heartfelt participation of village leaders, civil authorities, Muslim religious leaders. The church was built following all the regulations and the necessary legal process. This act of gratuitous violence surprises us, but we believe it is the work of few radical members who want to fuel, here and throughout Indonesia, religious hatred, intolerance and violence...The police are investigating. Acts of desecration like this are perceived as a shame for the whole society...we are saddened by this act but the solidarity received by many Muslims consoles us")

Central African Republic: Bangassou

Bishop Juan Jose Aguirre Munos MCCJ (Spanish citizen, described on [August 31, 2017](#) how his seminary in has taken in 2,000 Muslims who feared death at the hands of the anti-balaka militia; **UPDATE:** is about to return to his diocese from Spain, said that the Muslim refugees at the seminary have been starved by the anti-balaka blockade and sexually exploited by the UN peacekeepers "They are desperate, they die of hunger...I told him [UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres] that there are women who are raped, some of whom are minors, and that was a crime against humanity. An investigation has been opened, but nothing has changed. This is not the first time UN soldiers behave in this way. In 2015, a group of Congolese peacekeepers were expelled for offering lentil boxes in exchange for sex", added that anti-balaka dismember their victims ["The hearts or internal organs of the victims are torn because they say that in this way they steal their souls"] and spoke of himself "The Catholic Church is the last to turn off the light. We cannot leave. I do not sleep well, I am stressed. Every time I prayed I heard the explosion of bombs and gusts of machine guns. I had moments of psychological fragility and that is why I had to take a break")

Nigeria: Kaduna state

Sunny Isa (youth, reported to have said "They called us 'infidels'. "They also said we are 'poor' and that's why they date our girls and convert them to Islam and marry them. These insults and humiliation from the Muslim boys has been going on for long, so we decided to constitute a committee to stop our girls from dating Muslims, since Muslim girls are even prohibited from dating Christians")

Rev Danlami Gajere (reported to have commented on violence between Christians and Muslims over Muslims dating Christian girls "They [Muslim boys] date Christian girls and sleep with them and come to mock the Christians. They will tell us that they sleep with our wives and our daughters and call us 'infidels'. On the other hand it is an abomination for Muslim girls to date Christian girls. 'Who are you to date a Muslim girl!' They don't

even have regard for non-Muslims. That's the reason why Christian youths constituted a committee to stop Christian girls from dating Muslims – to avoid the insults and humiliation")

Rev Makama Mazadu (reported to have said "I was called by the Sarkin Kajuru [traditional ruler] for a meeting. When I went to the meeting, I saw a lady in hijab. The Sarki told me that as CAN chairman, he wants to tell me that the lady named Alheri wants to convert to Islam ... that she is [now] a Muslim and they wanted to let me know. I told him that this is unacceptable because I cannot handle this alone. I requested to take the girl along with me, but he said I can't go with the girl as she was already a Muslim. He said the Muslims had agreed that whoever wants to convert to Islam should, within eight to ten hours be converted")

Sunday "Sunny" Oibe (Public Relations Officer for the Christian Association of Nigeria, **UPDATE:** reported to have said "Abducted girls are always taken to the palaces of some traditional rulers, where the conversion and marriage takes place and when the matter is reported to the police, nothing is done to bring the culprits to justice. Why do Muslims find it convenient to marry Christian girls but [they] will not allow their own daughters to marry Christians? We must discourage [this]. Nigeria has a constitution and laws, but the only thing is that our security agencies are not living up to expectations. That is why this issue of abduction and forceful conversation has continued. The police should be able to arrest and prosecute all those doing this")

Nigeria: Nzharuvo village, Miango, near Jos, Plateau state

Christopher (aged 12, son of Joseph Gah Nze, twin brother of Emmanuel, **killed**)

Emmanuel (aged 12, son of Joseph Gah Nze, twin brother of Christopher, **killed**)

Peace Joseph (aged 6, son of Joseph Gah Nze, **killed**)

Henry Audu (aged 18, nephew of Joseph Gah Nze, **killed**)

Chanka Amos (aged 4, nephew of Joseph Gah Nze, wounded, hospitalized)

Joseph Gah Nze (aged 48, husband, father of Christopher, Emmanuel, and Peace Joseph, uncle of Henry Audu and Chanka Amos, said "My house is located in the outskirts of this area, and so it became the first to be attacked. But because the sound of gunshots in my house alerted the other Christians around here, they quickly mobilized themselves and repelled the attackers, forcing them to retreat")

Samaila Isa (aged 55, convert, husband of Jummai Samaila, father of nine, **shot dead**)

Jummai Samaila (aged 45, widow of Samaila Isa, mother of nine, said "I was woken up by heavy sounds of gunshots. The herdsmen shot at our windows, and as I woke up I saw dust all over the room. The room was covered with dust, and I could not see anything. I had to move my hand around in the dark in search of my child. I eventually found my child and held tight to it. There was shooting going on all around our house, and the whole house was shaking. I quickly ran to the children's room to ensure they were safe, and I found that they were safe. I wanted to go running out of the room, but one of my sons told me not to do so. The window in their room was opened. I lifted the curtain of the window slightly, and outside I saw six armed Fulani herdsmen. I moved away from the window and tried getting out, only to find that my husband was shot and was lying on the floor. I

could not move since the herdsmen were still in our house. I hid myself in a corner and watched as they carried my husband. Two of them carried his legs, while another two carried him from the chest up. One of them had a torchlight which was switched on to show them the way out of our house. As they made their way out of our house carrying my husband with them towards a stream just behind our house, my son urged me to open the door so that we can run out to seek for help. I opened the door, and we ran out")

Yusuf Samaila (aged 20, son of Samaila Isa, cut the hand of a gun toting Fulani Muslim with a machete, the gunman fled)

Mallam Isa (aged 80 plus, convert, father of Samaila Isa)

Rev Sunday Zibeh (said "We ran as they pursued us and were shooting at us at the same time. We ran to the area where the district headquarters of ECWA church is located here in Miango. The herdsmen, after a while, withdrew from pursuing us and retreated to the bush where they had emerged. It was after the herdsmen had retreated that I was alerted that they killed some children in one of my member's house. I rushed to the house to find that four children were killed in the house, and one was taken to the hospital...If all that is happening to Christians at this time is within the plans of God for us his children, then let His will be fulfilled in us, but if this is not the case, I have faith that God will raise he who will rescue us from these attacks of the herdsmen. I plead with other Christians to please stand in the gap for us and other Christians facing persecution in northern Nigeria. I also want to plead that should there be others who are being led by the Holy Spirit to help displaced Christians in northern Nigeria, they should please do so...In spite of the shortcomings I see in our government in Nigeria, I believe God will rescue us from this calamity. God alone can wipe away our tears in this part of Nigeria. As Christians, all we need do is to remain faithful to Jesus Christ, and this we can do by getting on our knees and being prayerful")

Rev Andrew Okebe (spoke after a Muslim attack in which nine were killed "As a pastor, I join other pastors to take our turns every night as part of the community vigilante. We can only take turns to sleep at night, but the issue here is, just as they came, how do we defend our village with sticks and torchlights? We can only raise alarms so people can run. But how far can you run from the bullet of an AK 47 in the dark?")

Mansour Borji (human rights spokesman, reported on the government seizure of a church retreat center "...[it is] not only a takeover of a property by corrupt judiciary and Intelligence officials, but yet another move in an ongoing and systematic campaign by the Iranian state to uproot Protestant Christianity...Labelling a long-standing and vibrant Church with national security charges for its rightful religious activities and accusing them of collusion with the CIA is indeed worrying. It should be a concern for anyone who is interested in safeguarding freedom of religion and belief in this country", added that churches have been forced to conduct only one service on Sundays "This was an attempt to restrict participation in services, especially for the converts to Christianity, as Sunday is a weekday and Friday is a day off for many people in the country. Training camps and programs held during the week were shut down too")

India: Sikandar Chavadi, Tamil Nadu state

Hindu radicals and police attacked a church

Persia Jacob (aged 38, wife of Pastor Ravi Jacob, mother of two girls aged 10 and 14, stripped of her sari, Bible seized, kicked in the face until unconscious, said “I will die, but I can’t do without the Bible...It was all too much – it caused lot of weakness. I couldn’t even stand or look at anyone even. My voice was gone; I soon fainted...The attackers on that day were forcefully taking away the Bibles to burn them. I was shocked. I didn’t know what to do. I held my Bible tight close to my heart. My Lord speaks to me from His Word...And, there is not a day I can go on without reading and knowing what He wants to tell me. Like a child, I was being stubborn at the same time I was also pleading”, said of her daughters “They are not going to school. They have never seen anything like this attack before”)

Pastor Ravi Jacob (aged 41, husband of Persia Jacob, beaten, chased over a kilometer to another village, threatened with death, said of his wife “She was kicked in the face with shoes. I tried hard but couldn’t protect her. She fell unconscious. She was lying there unconscious without her sari”)

Mariyammal (attempted to file a police report, was refused)

India: Koodul Pudur, Tamil Nadu state

Hindu radicals and police attacked a church

Pastor Jerome Jagatheesan (said of the Hindu radicals “They yelled at me, calling pottai, pottai [pervert]. The words they used were highly humiliating. I was told that I give my wife to adultery. She was standing there right next to me; I know how much it hurt her. She can’t take a word against me, and I’m sure by now my in-laws who live in Andhra Pradesh state also had watched the video. That was not the end of it. They stripped two female members of the church, ages 51 and 40, and a young 23-year-old woman was punched in her chest. Her mobile was thrown away”, police refused to register a case)

How dare you do Christian activities here?' ...I came out running and asked, 'What happened, babu? Why are you shouting? I could smell the stink of alcohol. They were drunk'")

Kolhapuri Prabhakar (son of Pastor Kolhapuri Lachaiah Moses, said "But they became aggressive, and started hitting my elderly father. When I tried to stop them, they punched me too. My mother and sister also rushed to help us, only to be pushed away by the drunk men. They yelled, 'We have been looking for you for the past six months, we got you today. We will not stop now.'")

Kolhapuri Immanuel (aged 20, son of Pastor Kolhapuri Lachaiah Moses, beaten, foot fractured)

Pastor Ravi Babu (said "A mob of 15 Hindu radicals followed me, when I was returning from [a nearby] village, after visiting [a] few Christian families [in] that village. Pakistan: Burewala

A church was attacked by at least 15 local Muslims, at least seven Christians were injured

Pastor Haleem Feroze Masih (said "Some of our church elders were trying to install a flex signboard in connection with the upcoming Easter festival on the wall in front of the church but they were stopped by Sharif's sons. Sharif is a local tough who has previously grabbed a piece of the Christian cemetery in our colony and built a cattle shed on the graves. He is also running a gambling den and is known to patronize criminals. The elders tried to reason with the youths, but it seems that the Muslims intentionally wanted to pick a fight with us. One of our church elders told the Muslims that they had desecrated biblical verses inscribed on the flex sign, to which they responded that, 'We are bigger than your Jesus'. Some of them whipped out their weapons and opened fire on the church members, who ran to save themselves. I immediately telephoned the police and headed out to try and defuse the situation. However, I was also beaten up, my service robe torn and my mobile phone smashed to the ground. I think we were fortunate that none of us suffered a fatal bullet injury during the clash. They also pelted stones at the police, but the policemen managed to arrest Sharif, his sons and another unidentified man from the spot while the others fled along with the weapons")

Iftikhar Bhatti (said "Hanging on the front of the church was a Christmas banner. Some of our church members went to replace it with an Easter banner, but they were stopped by Muhammad Sharif, a Muslim living in the area. Then the pastor went along to help attach the banner to the wall, but Sharif and his sons tore it down and trampled on it. The church service had ended by then and as church members started leaving they also got caught up in the clash...Why would Muhammad Sharif stop us from putting a banner on a Christian building? We resisted and then a fight broke out")

Bishop Abraham Daniel (said “The police have assured us of providing security to the area’s Christians and of proceeding against the accused Muslims in accordance with the law”)

Pakistan: Lahore, Punjab province

Sarfraz Victor (catechist, told parishioners at the cathedral “be on alert. Consider yourselves like security staff, protect yourselves and others, be friendly and work together with [police] agents” in the days leading to Easter)

William Arif Khan (cathedral security leader, said "No visitor will be allowed in without a national identity card. Action will be taken against any parishioner who brings a non-Christian to church Mass. Use of smartphone /social media will be prohibited inside Church premises...Volunteers with licensed weapons are already armed during Masses. But those without a license cannot do much in capturing an infiltrating terrorist. We have asked police to issue license for arms to protect churches")

Samuel Piyara (**UPDATE:** said "Punjab government has yet to implement SOPs, standard operation procedures, including installation of walk-through gates and posting of snipers in Churches. We shall file a contempt case if they continue ignoring the apex court verdict...A major concern of Islamabad churches is the irregularity of police [agents]. Most were busy on their mobile phones while on duty to protect worshipers. Also Church buildings were exempted from safe city project under which security cameras were installed in Islamabad")

They are just not protected in the same way", moved by campus security to a secure undisclosed location, fiancée threatened, after threatened with homosexual rape said it "very disturbing threat [and] a Title IX issue now...[a] lawsuit's not off the table by any stretch")

Dr James Keating (faculty advisor to Michael Smalanskas, reported to have criticized the college's lack of response to the attacks against Michael: "The example that I gave to [Vice President of Student Affairs] Kristine Goodwin is, let's say a young Mexican-American student had put up a poster that said, 'God loves the dreamers,' that poster had been torn down, and [the student who created it] felt unsafe in her own dormitory because kids who tore it down were milling outside her door. Then, a poster is put up of her being raped. How would the college react?")

Dr Matthew Cuddeback (reported to have said "President Shanley's [March 19] message to the Providence College community leaves Michael Smalanskas exposed. The President does not defend the bulletin board. He seems to imply that expressions of Catholic teaching on marriage should be confined largely to the classroom and the pulpit. And he leaves Michael exposed to the charge that the bulletin board is, in fact, 'uncharitable.'")

Bishop Thomas J Tobin (reported to have re-tweeted an article about college faculty who were supporting Michael Smalanskas and in effect asked why were anti-Christian students attending a nominally Christian college: "But, it seems to me that those who teach or study at a Catholic school should accept the stated identity and mission of the school? Otherwise, why are they there? There are lots of other good options")

Jayaramaiah (aged 70, widower of Chadarajupalli Subbaravamma)

Subba Rao (son of Chadarajupalli Subbaravamma, said “By the time we all went to the terrace, she was lying with her blouse by her side and the Bible thrown away, and her head bled profusely. She died on the spot. The neighbours saw him [the young man] beat her to death. She was knelt in prayer and fell with her face down. The blows were so heavy that her head is broken apart. Nobody should wish such painful death to their bitter enemies even...There was no chance for the killer to escape. He went and locked himself inside the bathroom. We don’t know to whom he made calls, but soon police arrived and pulled him out of the bathroom. We were howling in pain that ‘mother is dead; he killed her, he killed her’. But the police told us, ‘That fellow is mad’. I am not educated; my family survives only on [the produce from] our one-acre agriculture field. They asked me to ‘shut up’, and ‘don’t make a scene’. The police took the killer with them. The police had themselves written a complaint and took the signatures of my wife and assured us that the body will be taken for post-mortem, and we can perform the last rites after it. They told me if we inform any Christian leaders, they will take up protests and will not let us perform the last rites for at least ten days. They told me, ‘That fellow is mental, and there can’t be any complaint against him”)

Pastor Mohan Rao (said “Subbaravamma came to Christ ten years ago, took baptism and continued in faith until her death. On any Sunday, she would be the first one to make it to

the church. She was a strong believer...The church is shocked to hear the news and none of us is in accord with the police statements. They are cooking up a different version that she was mistaken for a young woman wearing the same colored sari. It is not true")

Six years ago when I started the church ministry in Afrin, I didn't know of any other Christian. Many of those who come to church are from Muslim background and they became Christians. Many people were coming to the church because they were really interested in knowing more about Christ. Those who attended said they felt peaceful and hopeful when they heard the gospel message.. Many of the other Christian families are still in Afrin and surrounding villages and are now trying to get out...Now they [Christians] are afraid that they could be persecuted for their faith. Many are terrified for their lives because of ISIL and other Islamic groups are moving around the town")

Egypt: El Toud, Qena province

Sami Farid (said of an attempt to license an unlicensed church "...news spread among the people of the village very quickly. Many Muslim villagers gathered in front of the 'house church' and threw stones at it. They also pelted the Copt homes next to the church. They shouted 'Allahu akbar' [Allah is greatest], and chanted slogans against the church. Then they blocked access to the street leading to the church...The committee members arrived at the village at midday to inspect the church, but they ran into a volatile crowd. The committee members called for the police to protect them. The police arrived at 3pm but didn't do anything, not arresting a single one of the extremists who attacked us...It is clear that [the law] does not apply to extremists who attack Christians")

Pastor Mark Follett (church vandalized with graffiti stating “[expletive] Christians” and “phoneys”, said “When I was a kid, I would’ve never thought that things like this would happen, but they are”)

It is because of my ideals of law and my faith's compassion that I served the church as a defense lawyer for ten years and assisted several hundred churches.

Remember me in your prayers, brothers and sisters! I have no clue whether I can endure violence and intimidation, but I will make an effort. Meanwhile, I have a word for the perpetrator: History has witnessed that none of those standing against God and the Church ended up well. I meant to focus on reading and writing at home and stay away from the mundane world. Nevertheless, you [government officials] have relentlessly harassed and hurt me so that I am sick of life, but I will never commit suicide. I am counting all evils you have done so far")

Pastor Safnia Bashir (said "We were not sure about holding a public rally. Just a month ago, most of the villagers had fled the village for fear of mob attack. Finally we decided to steer the worshippers only in the Christian neighborhood...Observe a fast and pray for an end to this lawlessness and terrorism. Pray for the rulers, even if you do not like them. We are only safe when our country is safe")

Hameed Masih (had fled his home, said "When we came back here two weeks later, we found our apartment had been trashed. All of our utensils and clothes were strewn over the floor. They had smashed our TV set and cupboards. The washing machine was wrecked.

They even damaged my neighbor's motorbike...We definitely got a boost from being able to profess our faith openly in the streets after being haunted and living in terror. It was a big deal")

Khalid Shehzad (activist, said "The pastor should have contacted the police and asked for reinforcements. Christian villagers could easily be targeted again. The authorities will blame the organizer of the rally if it provokes more attacks")

Bishop Emmanuel (**UPDATE**: has not been able to return to the village)

Pakistan: Lahore

Three Christian men were attacked by hospital security staff and by doctors wielding surgical instruments, a pane of glass, chairs and belts, the attack was triggered after the Christians had complained of inadequate medical care for a pregnant family member and were called insolent

Kiran Saleem (aged 30, wife of Kashif Shafeeq, denied medical care for her late term pregnancy until family members protested)

Kashif Shafeeq (husband of Kiran Saleem, attacked, treated for injuries)

Sunil Saleem (aged 28 or 34, husband of Asiya, father of four, brother of Kiran Saleem, attacked, **died from his injuries**)

Asiya (widow of Sunil Saleem, mother of four)

Anil Saleem (aged 27, brother of Kiran Saleem, attacked, treated for injuries, described the attack as "harrowing" and said "About 20 security guards and 14 doctors punched and attacked my brothers and cousins with batons, chairs and belts. We received internal injuries and called the police. The ribs and legs of Sunil were fractured. He fainted and later died in the same hospital")

Saleem Johnson (aged 60, father of Kiran Saleem)

Mehwish (aged 26, sister of Kiran, Anil and Sunil Saleem, said "I am deeply disturbed by what has happened to our family, we were expecting the birth of a new child into our growing family, but have now lost our eldest brother...The men who murdered our brother are meant to be doctors - people who save lives - how could this happen? Medical instruments were used to kill Sunil I saw the wounds myself and now I will be emotionally scarred for life. At this moment in time I just want to cry forever...I pray to God that he cares for my brother Sunil and seek his help now in obtaining justice")

Fr Qaiser Feroz (**UPDATE**: later said "This is a first of its kind tragedy...People visit hospitals for treatment and doctors are supposed to save lives")

Christian leaders condemned the acquittal of 20 perpetrators of the November 4, 2014 lynching of Shahzad and Shama Masih

Tahir Naveed Chaudhry (attorney, **UPDATE**: said "Unfortunately, government prosecutors often fail to do their job which results in the acquittal of culprits")

Hyacinth Peter (**UPDATE**: said "None of those arrested in mob attacks on religious minorities have been punished in the history of the country. Courts are pressurized by fanatics who use both their finances and influences to free their goons. They openly abuse judges")

I went to talk, and find what they are up to, but they held me by my collar and alleged: ‘You are carrying out conversions here!’ I tried to calm them down and make them understand that I only baptize those who come forward willingly, and there is no force. But they were not convinced. They started punching me, and rushed inside the kitchen in the church building and picked some knives. I did not want them to cause harm to anyone, so I quietly took the beatings”, after prayer decided to not file a police report)

Dinesh Kumar (aged 25, attempted to protect Pastor Jose Prakash, "badly" beaten, detained by police, hospitalized with head, eye, and ear injuries and headaches, nausea, and vomiting, "condition is worsening")

Prem (aged 45, new convert, baptismal candidate, beaten, detained by police, hospitalized)
