released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Bishop Joanikije (arrested in [Niksic](#) on [May 12, 2020](#) after parishioners protested the government cancellation of Liturgies due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Bishop Metodije (beaten by police on [December 26, 2019](#) at the [Durdevica Tara Bridge](#) while peacefully protesting a new law which authorized the confiscation of church property, two others beaten while protecting him, hospitalized)

Fr Mirceta Sljivancanin (detained in [Podgorica](#) on [June 14, 2020](#) for 72 hours and interrogated for a COVID-19 lockdown violation)

Fr Mirko Vukotic (arrested in [Niksic](#) on [May 12, 2020](#) after parishioners protested the government cancellation of Liturgies due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Fr Nikola Marojevic (arrested in [Niksic](#) on [May 12, 2020](#) after parishioners protested the government cancellation of Liturgies due to the COVID-19 pandemic;
released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Fr Nikola Radovic (home in [Stari Bar](#) surrounded by young people on [May 21, 2020](#), threatened, wife and children frightened, people left after he began to video record the confrontation,

later offered to pay the fine for the principal offender)

Fr Ostoja Knezevic (arrested in [Niksic](#) on [May 12, 2020](#) after parishioners protested the government cancellation of Liturgies due to the COVID-19 pandemic;

released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Deacon Pavle Ljeskovic (detained in [Budva](#) on [June 14, 2020](#) and interrogated for a COVID-19 lockdown violation)

Fr Sasa Janjic (detained in [Pljevlja](#) on [June 14, 2020](#), released and interrogated for a COVID-19 lockdown violation)

Fr Slobodan Jokic (arrested in [Niksic](#) on [May 12, 2020](#) after parishioners protested the government cancellation of Liturgies due to the COVID-19 pandemic;

released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Fr Stefan Milovanovic (husband, father, Serbian citizen, as of [July 8, 2020](#) has been ordered to leave the country from [Berane](#) for alleged quarantine violations despite the fact that his wife is a citizen, denied he had violated any regulations)

Fr Vasilije Brboric (arrested in [Niksic](#) on [May 12, 2020](#) after parishioners protested the government cancellation of Liturgies due to the COVID-19 pandemic;

released on bail on [May 16, 2020](#))

Fr Zeljko Calic (detained in [Danilovgrad](#) on [June 14, 2020](#) for 72 hours and interrogated for a COVID-19 lockdown violation)
