South Korea

- Archbishop Andrew Yeom Soo-jung (in his Easter message in Seoul on March 31, 2013 asked for prayers for "those suffering from physical and spiritual pain" and especially "for the brothers and sisters of North Korea" during the current threats of war)
- Augustine Nam Yoo-chul (aged 35, teacher, drowned on April 16, 2014 while saving dozens of his students in the Sewol ferry disaster off Gwanmaedo Island, his last act was to give his life jacket to one of his students)
- Dr Kang Dae-gun (aged 82, announced his retirement from dentistry on May 7, 2013, in 33 years had treated 15,000 lepers for free in Seodaemun-gu, Seoul)
- Bishop Linus Lee Seong-hyo (criticized a Daejeon court for handing down suspended sentences on July 18, 2013 for four abortionists who had carried out 405 illegal abortions)
- Thomas Cha Hee-jae (president of the Korean Pro-Life Doctors Association, accused the Daejeon court of ignoring the law when it handed down suspended sentences on July 18, 2013 for four abortionists who had carried out 405 illegal abortions)
