Belgium: Brussels

Edith Louisa Cavell (aged 49, British citizen, nurse, hospital supervisor, saved many soldiers and military age civilians on both sides of the war, arrested by the German Army on August 3, 1915 for aiding the escape of enemy soldiers; **UPDATE**: shot dead by a firing squad, said before her death "Patriotism is not enough. I must have no hatred or bitterness towards anyone...Ask Father Gahan to tell my loved ones later on that my soul, as I believe, is safe, and that I am glad to die for my country... I have no fear or shrinking; I have seen death so often it is not strange, or fearful to me!")

Pastor Paul Le Seur (German army chaplain, said "Miss Cavell was a very brave woman and a faithful Christian")
