**United States - Washington: Camp Lewis** 

Four Christian conscientious objectors were arrested on May 28, 1918 for refusing to cooperate with their military induction, were later beaten; UPDATE: courtmartialed, convicted, and sentenced to 37 years' imprisonment;

Russia: Pokrovskoe village, Yarkovsky District, Tyumen Oblast

Bishop Hermogenes aka Georgiy Yefremovich Dolganyov (aged 60, had expelled Joseph Dzhugashvili [aka Joseph Stalin] from the seminary in 1899, exiled without trial to a monastery by the Tsar in 1911 after he physically assaulted Grigori Rasputin; **UPDATE**: drowned by the Bolsheviks in the Tura River)

**United States - Washington: Camp Lewis** 

Four Christian conscientious objectors were arrested on May 28, 1918 for refusing to cooperate with their military induction, were later beaten; court-martialed on June 10, 2018, convicted, and sentenced to 37 years' imprisonment; UPDATE: transferred to Alcatraz Federal Prison in California, upon arrival they were beaten, starved, subjected to cold and damp, and denied clothing other than military uniforms which they refused, developed eczema and scurvy

Fr Piotr Emelianov (aged 34, converted from the Russian Orthodox Church to the Russian Catholic Church, as a result suffered frequent attacks and beatings along with his parishioners, later arrested in 1918 in succession by the Whites, Germans, Ukrainians, and Bolsheviks)
