Ukraine: Nizhne-Bogdanovka, outside Luhansk

Fr Piotr Emelianov (aged 35, converted from the Russian Orthodox Church to the Russian Catholic Church on June 29, 1918, as a result suffered frequent attacks and beatings along with his parishioners, later arrested in 1918 in succession by the Whites, Germans, Ukrainians, and Bolsheviks; released by the Bolsheviks on December 27, 1918; UPDATE: arrested again by the Whites)
