Patriarch Tikhon aka Vasily Ivanovich Bellavin (aged 55, U.S. citizen; **UPDATE**: wrote to Lenin requesting the re-opening of the Trinity Lavra of St Sergius for worship)

Russia: Petrograd

Fr Peter Janukowicz (aged 57, arrested in August 1919, sentenced to a week of forced labor; **UPDATE**: arrested on a charge of 'keeping the dead in the church', sentenced to one years' imprisonment)
