Mykola Dmytrovych Leontovych (aged 44, composer of the melody of *The Carol of the Bells*, shot dead by a Chekist assassin in his parent's home)

Russia: Malinchevsky, outside Tomsk

Fr Franciszek Grabowski (aged 48, banished from Ufa in 1918 by the White [anti-Communist] government to Malinchevsky, outside Tomsk for failing to support the collaboration of Polish soldiers with the Whites; arrested by the Cheka [Communist secret police] in 1920, soon released in an amnesty; **UPDATE**: arrested in early 1921 by the Communists after having expressed his views in the hearing of a Polish Communist, shot dead)
