Wednesday June 1, 1921



United States – Oklahoma: Tulsa

End of the Tulsa Race Massacre: Up to 300 African-Americans would be killed and 40 city blocks including up to 16 churches would be destroyed in a 24 hour riot

Mary Jo Erhard (YWCA resident, hid a YWCA African-American employee from rioters)

O T Johnson (Salvation Army commandant, later supervised the burials of 120 African-Americans in unmarked graves)
