## Russia: Donskoy Monastery, Moscow

Jacob Anisimovich Polozov (aged 45, husband of Natalia V Drutsk-Sokolinskii, father, attendant to Patriarch Tikhon, arrested on March 19, 1921; released on November 23, 1921; arrested on March 22, 1922; transferred to the prison hospital in August 1922 due to a severe neurological disorder; released on October 10, 1922; **UPDATE**: shot dead during an assassination attempt on Patriarch Tikhon)

Patriarch Tikhon aka Vasily Ivanovich Bellavin (aged 59, U.S. citizen, placed under house arrest in April 1922; released in June 1923 after an international outcry; **UPDATE**: survived an attempted assassination)
