Russia: Leningrad

Edward Sievers (aged 24, taken from the [Savvo-Krypetskiy Monastery](#) on or about [October 14, 1919](#) by Bolsheviks and shot, left for dead, recovered; **UPDATE:** ordained, took the name of Fr Sergius)

Russia: Moscow

Fr Dominik Ivanov-Stolbinsky (aged 42, arrested on [March 10, 1923](#); sentenced on [March 26, 1923](#) to 3 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE:** released, returned to Leningrad, taught in an underground seminary)

Fr Peter Janukowicz (aged 62, arrested on [March 10, 1923](#); sentenced on [March 26, 1923](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in Lefortovo Prison; **UPDATE:** released, returned to Leningrad)
