John Elias Williams (aged 56, husband of Cora Lilian Caldwell, father of four, missionary, U.S. citizen, Union College vice-president, shot dead on his campus by a National Revolutionary Army soldier during the anti-foreign Nanking Incident)

Minnie Vautrin (aged 40, missionary, U.S. citizen, Ginling College president, hidden in the faculty dormitory attic by students and Chinese faculty)

Rev John Magee (aged 42, home spared from arson, one of only a few foreigners' homes spared)
