Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Pawel Chomicz (aged 33, arrested in [Leningrad](#) on [December 3, 1926](#), charged with counter-revolutionary activities; sentenced on [June 27, 1927](#) to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE:** arrived)

Anna Leszczynska OSF (aged 49, arrested on January 14, 1927; **UPDATE:** sentenced to internal exile, fate unknown)

Teresa Andreyeva OFS (aged 60, librarian, arrested on [January 19, 1927](#); **UPDATE:** sent into internal exile)

Weronika Gajlesz (aged 40, factory worker, arrested on [January 14, 1927](#); **UPDATE:** sent into internal exile, fate unknown)

Sr Wiktoria Kazkowa-Kaszczuk (aged 46, arrested on [January 14, 1927](#); **UPDATE:** sentenced to internal exile, sent to Kostroma in Russia)

Russia: Leningrad

Fr Dominik Ivanov-Stolbinsky (aged 44, arrested on [January 25, 1927](#), charged with 'organization of an illegal seminary, contacts with Jesuits abroad, hiding Polish spies in his apartment'; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Piotr Liuro (aged 56, bookkeeper, parish council president, investigated in [1919](#), not convicted; arrested on [January 13, 1927](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Elena Belyayeva OPL (aged 59, arrested on [January 13, 1927](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' internal exile, fate unknown)

Sr Lidia Gildebrandt OSF SVP (aged 38, widow, mother of a young daughter, arrested in [Petrograd](#) on [January 10, 1924](#); sentenced on May 19, 1924 to 10 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: transferred to Yaroslavl Prison, placed in solitary)

Albina Leyman (aged 37, arrested in [January 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Franciszka Kokina (aged 39, factory worker, arrested in [January 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Ivan Kupchin (aged 25, underground seminarian, arrested on [January 14, 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Ludwig Kokin (aged 42, church guard, arrested in [January 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Maria Baszynska (aged 46, arrested in [January 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Maria Levingof (aged 50, French national, arrested in [January 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)

Viktorina Balchunas (cook, arrested in [January 1927](#); **UPDATE**: released)
