Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Leonard Baranowski (aged 53, arrested in Vitebsk, Belarus in early June 1925, sentenced on June 26, 1925 to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; sent to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp in the summer of 1926, where he was described as a "zealous priest with very firm principles, especially in the struggle with Bolshevism"; UPDATE: released from imprisonment, sentenced to 3 years' internal exile in Togur, Narym region)

Bishop Arkady Ostalsky (aged 40, arrested at the New Athos monastery in Georgia in April 1927, later exiled to Kazan; moved without permission to Leningrad in March 1928, performed underground ministry, later moved to Moscow; arrested in May 1928; UPDATE: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment, later extended to 10 years, sent to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)
