Wednesday September 5, 1928



Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Siergiej Karpinski (former seminarian, arrested in Petrograd in November 1923; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on May 19, 1924, sent to Orel Prison; transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp in 1925, worked in a sawmill; **UPDATE**: secretly ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Boleslaw Sloskan)

Fr Franciszek Budzinski (aged 37, arrested on June 8, 1928 in Zhytomyr, Ukraine; **UPDATE**: charged with 'distributing religious literature' i.e. prayer books)

Sunday September 30, 1928



Ukraine: Kharkiv Prison

Fr Roman Jankowski (aged 40, arrested in Berdychiv on April 10, 1927 on charges of organizing illegal border crossings; sent to Kharkiv Prison in May 1928; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 9 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sentenced then reduced to 6 years' in an amnesty to commemorate the 10th anniversary of the Revolution)
