### **Ukraine: Selz, Odessa district**

Fr Johannes Furcht (aged 39, arrested on [October 23, 1928](#) on anti-Soviet agitation charges;

### **Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp**

Fr Siergiej Karpinski (former seminarian, arrested in Petrograd in November 1923; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on May 19, 1924, sent to Orel Prison; transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp in 1925, worked in a sawmill; secretly ordained to the priesthood on September 5, 1928 by Bishop Boleslaw Sloskan; **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island)
