Fr Franciszek Budzinski (aged 38, arrested on June 8, 1928 in Zhytomyr, Ukraine; charged on September 13, 1928 with 'distributing religious literature' i.e. prayer books; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 2 years' imprisonment)

Pawel Golowanczuk (aged 29, arrested in Makovets on July 20, 1928; **UPDATE**: sentenced to death, sentence later commuted for a possible prisoner exchange with Poland, transferred to Yaroslavl Political Isolator, fate unknown)

Sabin Jaworski (aged 23, church sacristan, arrested in Hnivan on April 1, 1928, charged that 'he travelled from village to village with priests, dissuading Polish youth from joining Komsomol or going to clubs and the movies, and urging them to attend church'; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Yaroslavl Prison in Russia, fate unknown)

Ukraine: Vinnytsia

Fr Boleslaw Las (aged 24, U.S. citizen, arrested on December 1, 1927 during an illegal border crossing, soon released; **UPDATE**: arrested, sentenced to death)
