Zygmunt Lepesowecki (aged 51, office worker, arrested in Kiev, Ukraine on February 16, 1929, and sent into 3 years' internal exile to Siberia; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Fr Wiktor Krywenczyk (aged 31, arrested in Brusyliv, Ukraine in May 1926, sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: sent into 3 years' internal exile to Irkutsk)
