Fr Timothy Leonard SSC (aged 36, Irish citizen, hacked to death by Communist guerrillas after they invaded the church, interrupted Mass and trampled on consecrated hosts)

Fr Jan Lewinski (aged 58, arrested on May 5, 1922 for concealing church valuables, sentenced to four months incarceration and forced labor; **UPDATE**: arrested, released soon after)

Russia: Butyrka Prison, Moscow

Fr Franciszek Budzinski (aged 38, arrested on June 8, 1928 in Zhytomyr, Ukraine; charged on September 13, 1928 with 'distributing religious literature' i.e. prayer books; sentenced to

2 years' imprisonment on February 11, 1929; **UPDATE**: sent to Kem, later transferred to Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp)

Russia: Solovetsky Special Purpose Camp

Fr Adolf Filipp (aged 44, arrested in Vitebsk, Ukraine on January 10, 1927 on 'anti-Soviet agitation' charges; sentenced on June 20, 1927 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: transferred to Anzer Island as "a convict who was very resolute in the expression of his views")
