Germany

Fr Titus Maria Horton OP (aged 53, convicted on currency violations, sentenced to 2 years' imprisonment and fined 75,000 Reichmarks)

Tuesday November 19, 1935



Russia: Voronezh

Fr Adam Gareis (aged 48, arrested in [Orenburg](#) on [January 21, 1930](#); sentenced on [June 6, 1931](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, commuted to internal exile; arrested in [Tambov](#) in [December 1934](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Belbaltlag)

Fr Johannes Beilmann (aged 57; arrested on [February 2, 1930](#) in [Armavir](#); sentenced on [June 6, 1931](#) in [Moscow](#) to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, commuted to 3 years' internal exile; arrested on [January 4, 1935](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Joseph Josiukas (Lithuanian citizen, arrested in [Cherny Ostrov, Ukraine](#) in [1928](#); banished in [March 1929](#) from border regions, settled in [Yaroslavl, Russia](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)

Bishop Peter Legge (aged 53, brother of Fr Theodor Legge, arrested on currency violations in [Meissen](#) on [October 9, 1935](#); **UPDATE**: convicted, fined 100,000 Reichmarks, prohibited from performing his ministry)

Semyon Krisko (aged 55, driver, investigated for petty theft in [1930](#), not convicted; arrested on [April 29, 1935](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 3 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to the Kem sector of Belbaltlag in Russia)

Vladimir Balashev OPL (aged 55, engineer, released from internal exile prior to August 1935; arrested in [Dmitrov, Moscow region](#) on [August 15, 1935](#); **UPDATE**: sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

Fr Jozef Berezowski (aged 48, arrested in 1922 for ‘opposing the seizure of church valuables’, released; **UPDATE**: arrested, sentenced to 8 years’ imprisonment in a labor camp, fate unknown)
