Fr Maximilian Maria Kolbe OFM Conv aka Raymund Kolbe (aged 47, arrested by the Germans on September 19, 1939 in Niepokalanow monastery, Teresin; released on December 8, 1939; **UPDATE:** rearrested with four others by the Gestapo, beaten in prison, developed pneumonia)
