Poland - now Belarus: outside Nowogrodek

Eleven nuns shot dead by the Gestapo and buried in a mass grave

Liane Berkowitz (aged 19, arrested on [September 26, 1942](#) for anti-Nazi activities, gave birth to Irina Berkowitz on [April 12, 1943](#), UPDATE: **guillotined**)

Monday August 9, 1943



Germany: Berlin

Franz Jagerstatter OFS (aged 36, husband of Franziska, father of Hildegard, Rosi, Maria, and Louisi, Austrian national, conscientious objector, arrested in the army garrison in [Enns, Austria](#) on [March 1, 1943](#) after refusing to take the Hitler Oath, sent to prison in Linz; transferred to prison in [Berlin-Tegel](#) on [May 4, 1943](#); convicted in [Berlin-Charlottenburg](#) of undermining military morale and sentenced to death on [July 6, 1943](#); **UPDATE: guillotined**, last words were "I am completely bound in inner union with the Lord")

Germany: Plotzensee prison, Berlin

Fr Jacob Gapp SM (aged 46, tricked by two German agents posing as catechumens into crossing the Spanish border into France, arrested by the Gestapo in [Hendaye](#) on [November 9, 1942](#); **UPDATE: guillotined** for anti-Nazi homilies and activities)
