Wednesday September 1, 1943



**Germany: Dusseldorf** 

Fr Roger Derry (aged 42, French citizen, arrested in Paris on October 9, 1941; **UPDATE**: sentenced to death)

#### Turkmenistan

Fr Franciszek Janocha OFM (aged 31, arrested in Lviv by the Soviets in July 1940, sentenced to death, commuted to imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Unzhlag; amnestied as a Polish citizen on September 2, 1941; appointed chaplain of the Polish Armed Forces of the East on March 1, 1942 in Chok-Pak, Kazakhstan; arrested on March 20, 1943 on anti-Soviet and espionage charges; UPDATE: sentenced to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Ukhtizhemlag)

**Vatican City** 

Pope Pius XII aka Eugenio Maria Giuseppe Giovanni Pacelli (aged 67, **UPDATE**: told his closest aides that his arrest by the Germans could be imminent, had said "If they want to arrest me they will have to drag me from the Vatican...the person who would leave under these conditions would not be Pius XII but Eugenio Pacelli", thus indicating his resignation as Pope would take effect at that moment)

#### Germany: Plotzensee prison, Berlin

Theodor Hespers (aged 39, fled Germany in April 1933 to publish anti-Nazi Christian literature in the Netherlands, became a Dutch citizen; arrested by the Gestapo in Antwerp on February 10, 1942, tortured; sentenced to death on July 22, 1943; **UPDATE**: hanged)
