France: Communay, Rhone

Fernand Belot (aged 26, husband of Raymonde Guyon-Belot, published Christian and anti-Nazi literature, with his wife organized a network to help Jews escape to Switzerland, arrested

along with his wife, father, and in-laws on March 27, 1944 in Lyon, tortured; **UPDATE**: shot dead by the Germans along with 18 other prisoners at the edge of a highway)

France: Tulle

Fr Jean Espinasse (arrested by the Germans at his home after a failed Resistance uprising, reported to have managed to stop the hanging of suspected Resistance fighters, but only after 99 had been hung)

France: Oradour-sur-Glane

German SS soldiers killed 642 men, women, and children in reprisal for local Resistance activities, the women and children had been killed in the village church, the village was largely destroyed and was later preserved as the Germans left it as a memorial

Fr Jacques Lorich (aged 47, killed)

Fr Jean-Baptiste Chapelle (aged 71, killed)

Russia: Zerkaly, Shipunovsk region

Fr Johannes Lang (aged 62, deported from Rostov-on-Don on September 18, 1941 along with a large number of Germans to Shipunovo, Altay krai; sent to Zerkaly, Shipunovsk region in February 1942, forced by poverty to perform solder repairs; **UPDATE**: died, death believed to be from mishandling of soldering materials)

Fr Corentin Chika OFM (aged 50, shot by two French Gestapo agents in his rectory, died at a nearby clinic, forgave his killers and said "I offer my life for my brethren and the country")

Italy: Civitella in Val di Chiana

Fr Alcide Lazzeri (tried to shelter the townspeople in the church when German SS soldiers arrived to kill them in retribution for the deaths of three Germans, gave them absolution, shouted at the Germans "I'm responsible for what happened, kill me", killed along with 243 others)
