Fr Joseph Verbis LaFleur (aged 32, U.S. Army Air Force chaplain, POW, killed when the Japanese 'hell ship' Shinyo Maru carrying over 750 POWs was torpedoed by the USS Paddle and sank while Japanese guards shot survivors)

Germany: Torgau

Fr Carl Lampert (aged 50, arrested in Innsbruck, Austria on August 25, 1940 and sent to Dachau for publishing an obituary on the death of Fr Otto Neuruer; sent to Sachsenhausen on September 1, 1940; sent to Dachau on December 15, 1940; freed on August 1, 1941; arrested in Stettin on February 4, 1943, tortured; sent to Torgau on January 14, 1944; UPDATE: sentenced to death)

Germany: Brandenburg an der Havel

Fr Alois Grimm SJ (aged 57, Austrian, arrested in October 1943 for religious instructions he had given to SS officers, both of whom testified against him; sentenced to death on August 12, 1944, later wrote "The hour has come, I am going home into eternity. In a few hours, I will stand in front of my Judge, my Redeemer and my Father. It is God's will, to be done everywhere. Don't mourn over me, I am returning home, you have to wait. I give my life for the kingdom of God, which knows no end, for the Society of Jesus, for the youth and religion of our home land"; UPDATE: hanged)

Fr Joseph Muller (aged 50, guillotined, had been convicted of telling a joke: "A soldier on his deathbed asked to see the people for whom he was laying down his life. A portrait of Adolf Hitler was laid on his one side, a portrait of Hermann Goring on the other. He gasped 'Now I can die like Jesus Christ, between two criminals'", had refused to say who had told him the joke)

Giovanni Palatucci (aged 35, police official, arrested by the Germans for attempting to collaborate with the Allies, sent to Dachau, had saved Jews)

Germany: Dachau Concentration Camp

Yolande Beekman (aged 33, British citizen, Special Operations agent, denied access to a priest prior to her execution, shot dead along with 3 other female British agents)

Germany: Straflager Zoschen detention facility, Freyburg

Rev Clifford John Cohu (aged 60. husband of Harriet, British citizen, arrested in Guernsey on March 12, 1943 for disseminating war news ['anti-German propaganda'] including in his homilies; convicted on April 9, 1943, sentenced to 18 months' imprisonment; deported to France in July 1943; transferred to Preungesheim in March 1944, kept in solitary confinement without heat, starved, forced to work; **UPDATE**: arrived, beaten)

Fr Luis Blanco Suarez SJ (aged 58, Spanish citizen, expelled from Yap in July 1944 by Japanese authorities; UPDATE: shot dead by Japanese soldiers)

Fr Marino de la Hoz del Canto SJ (aged 58, Spanish citizen, shot dead by Japanese soldiers)

Rev Clifford John Cohu (aged 60. husband of Harriet, British citizen, arrested in Guernsey on March 12, 1943 for disseminating war news ['anti-German propaganda'] including in his homilies; convicted on April 9, 1943, sentenced to 18 months' imprisonment; deported to France in July 1943; transferred to Preungesheim in March 1944, kept in solitary confinement without heat, starved, forced to work; arrived at Straflager Zoschen on September 13, 1944, beaten; UPDATE: died of dysentery)

Fr Stefan Popvasilev (aged 45, husband, father of three, beaten and tortured by Communists, shot dead with up to 60 others, body burned)

Tuesday September 26, 1944



Germany: Berlin

Josef Muller (aged 46, husband of Maria, father of Christa, attorney, arrested in Munich on April 5, 1943 by the army for his involvement as a courier between the German ant-Nazi resistance and the Vatican; found innocent at trial in Berlin on March 3, 1944, rearrested by the army because the SS threatened to arrest him and the military did not want him in SS custody; UPDATE: transferred to SS custody)

Italy: Marzabotto, Monte Sole area

Fr Ubaldo Marchiono (aged 26, shot dead by the German SS during Mass, fell onto the altar, parishioners in the church were then attacked with grenades, mother and sister also killed)

Sr Maria Norina Fiori OSF (aged 21, killed by the German SS along with members of her First Communion class)
