Thursday February 1, 1945

Fr Karl Otto von Witowski OSB (aged 59, abbot, German citizen, killed while protecting women from rape)

Friday February 2, 1945



Germany: Plotzensee Prison, Berlin

Fr Alfred Delp SJ (aged 38, arrested by the Gestapo in Munich on July 28, 1944 in connection with the plot to assassinate Hitler; secretly made his final vows on December 9, 1944 in Tegel Prison in Berlin; sentenced to death on January 11, 1945; UPDATE: hanged, his last joking words to the prison chaplain were "In half an hour, I'll know more than you do")

Germany: Gestapo prison, Berlin

Pastor Dietrich Bonhoeffer (aged 39, fiancé of Maria von Wedemeyer; **UPDATE**: transferred to Buchenwald)

Josef Muller (aged 46, husband of Maria, father of Christa, attorney, interrogated by the SS in November 1944, told that he was a dead man, replied that death was just a passage to eternal life, when asked if he prayed he replied yes, including for the SS and all his enemies; **UPDATE**: transferred to Buchenwald)

Br William Kelly FSC (aged 50, Irish citizen, President of De La Salle College, abducted on February 10, 1945 by Japanese Marines; **UPDATE**: assumed killed [official date of death], body not recovered)

Seventy civilians including 16 Christian Brothers were attacked by Japanese troops while taking refuge in their school chapel

Fr Richard Henkes (aged 43, German citizen, arrested on April 8, 1943 in Strahovice, Czech Republic by the Gestapo on a charge of "sedition of the nation from the pulpit" for his anti-Nazi homilies; transferred to Dachau on July 10, 1943; **UPDATE**: died of typhus, had volunteered to care for the sick and dying)

Fr Stefan Singer (aged 73, died)

Germany: near Erlangen, Barvaria

Josef Mayr-Nusser (aged 34, husband of Hildegard, father of Alberto aged 2, Italian citizen, drafted into the German SS in or near Bolzano, Italy, sent to Prussia in Germany for training on September 7, 1944; refused to take the oath of allegiance to Adolph Hitler on October 4, 1944, said "I cannot take an oath to Hitler in the name of God. I cannot do it because my faith and conscience do not allow it", arrested; **UPDATE**: sentenced to death in Danzig in early 1945, transferred to Dachau for execution, died from dysentery on the train prior to his arrival at Dachau, found with a Bible and rosary)

Germany: Neuengamme concentration camp

Eugene Pons (aged 59, printer, published Christian and anti-Nazi literature, arrested May 22, 1944 in Lyon, France; **UPDATE**: died during deportation to Neuengamme)
