Fr Lucien Louis Bunel OCD (aged 45, arrested on January 15, 1944 along with three Jewish students he had been harboring at his boarding school in Avon, Seine-et-Marne, France, sent to Mauthansen-Gusen Concentration Camp, later managed to stay at Mauthansen despite the harsher conditions there and minister to his fellow prisoners when all other priest inmates were sent to Dachau; UPDATE: died of tuberculosis)
