Bishop Nikolay Charnetsky CSSR (aged 61, arrested on April 11, 1945; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp in Siberia)

Albania: Shkoder

#### Eight priests were taken from prison to a cemetery by Communists and shot

Fr Daniel Dajani SJ (aged 39, Italian citizen, seminary rector, arrested on war crimes and espionage charges on December 31, 1945, tortured; sentenced to death on February 22, 1946; **UPDATE**: shot dead)

Fr Giovanni Fausti SJ (aged 47, Italian citizen, arrested on war crimes and espionage charges on December 31, 1945, tortured; sentenced to death on February 22, 1946; **UPDATE**: shot dead)

Gjelosh Lulashi (aged 20, shot dead)

Fr Kole Shllaku OFM (aged 39, sentenced to death on February 22, 1946; UPDATE: shot dead)

Mark Cuni (aged 27, seminarian, shot dead)

Qerim Sadiku (aged 27, shot dead)

#### Wednesday March 6, 1946



**Ukraine: Zhytomyr** 

Fr Bronislaw Drzepecki (aged 40, arrested by the Germans in 1944 in Lutsk, taken to Lubin, later released; arrested by the Soviets on January 10, 1945; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)

#### Saturday March 9, 1946



**Ukraine:** Lviv

Fr Dionizy Kajetanowicz (aged 68, arrested on November 27, 1945 after refusing to join the Orthodox church; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Stalinsk oblast)

Fr Wiktor Kwapinski (aged 62, arrested early in 1941 in Lviv, survived the mass shootings in Kiev Prison in June 1941 following the German invasion, returned to Lviv and resumed his ministry; arrested in 1945; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp)
