#### Lithuania: Vilnius

Maryte (sister of Bishop Vincentas Borisevicius, laundered his torn, bloody, and sewage-laden clothing from captivity, **UPDATE:** present at his trial)

Bishop Vincentas Borisevicius (aged 58, brother of Maryte, arrested on February 3, 1946 in Telsiai, tortured and beaten; **UPDATE:** convicted of anti-Soviet activities, sentenced to death)
