Russia: Temlag labor camp, Yavas, Zubovo-Polyansk raion, Mordovian ASSR

Fr Pietro Leoni SJ (aged 38, Italian citizen, arrested on [April 29, 1945](#) in [Odessa, Ukraine](#); transferred to [Lefortovo Prison in Moscow](#) on [July 13, 1945](#); indicted on anti-Soviet agitation charges on September 13, 1945; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [November 12, 1945](#); transferred to [Butyrka Prison](#) on [November 24, 1945](#); transferred to [Temlag](#) on [December 12, 1945](#); **UPDATE**: arrested on false charges of preparing an armed uprising in the camp)
