Fr Jozef Beljawski (aged 62, arrested in Vilnius, Lithuania on July 11, 1946; sentenced to death on April 4, 1947, commuted to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: arrived at Sevvostoklag labor camp)

Russia: Temlag labor camp, Yavas, Zubovo-Polyansk raion, Mordovian ASSR

Fr Pietro Leoni SJ (aged 38, Italian citizen, arrested on April 29, 1945 in Odessa, Ukraine; transferred to Lefortovo Prison in Moscow on July 13, 1945; indicted on anti-Soviet agitation charges on September 13, 1945; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on November 12, 1945; transferred to Butyrka Prison on November 24, 1945; transferred to Temlag on December 12, 1945; arrested on June 15, 1947 on false charges of preparing an armed uprising in the camp; sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on August 29, 1947; **UPDATE**: transferred to Dubravlag)
